Metal: Gold

Work: One short shaft, 15-20 feet deep and a few shallow cuts.

Geology: The gold occurs in minute specks (flour gold) in weathered granite that contains yellow and red iron oxides. It could be considered to be in part residual due to weathering in place of the gold-bearing material. Some local areas have a little placer material. Preliminary tests show up to \$12 in gold, no average having been determined, according to Holder.
