Field Engineer's Report

Location: About 9 miles SW of Patagonia and near the 3 R Mine. From Patagonia take the Patagonia-Nogales road for a distance of about 5 miles. Turn left (SE) and drive on the 3 R Mine road for a distance of about $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles. Turn right and drive an additional 1/2 mile to the mine.

No. of Claims: 1

Owner: Floyd R. Bekins, 301 Copo de Oro Road, Los Angeles 14, Calif., reported to have purchased the claim from George Morris.

Operator: Joe Banta, Nogales Star Route, Nogales, Ariz., will do the mining on agreement with Mr. Bekins.

Principal Minerals: Siliceous Gold ore.

Present Mining Activity: Installing mining equipment, and expect to be ready to ship ore in about 2 weeks. Road into the property has already been built.

Ore Values: Ore reported by Mr. Banta to contain 80 to 88% Silica. Gold values vary within wide limits, and samples as high as 1.31 oz. per ton are reported by Mr. Banta.

Milling & Marketing Facilities: Operator will ship ore direct to the A.S. & R. Smelter either to Hayden or El Paso as high silica flux ore.

Old Mine Workings: Old mine workings on the property reported by Mr. Banta, are 4 adits from 25 ft. to 60 ft. in length -- (1 - 60'; 1 - 40'; 1 - 30' and 1 - 25').

Mining Operations: Expected to be underground operations starting from the old adits mentioned above.
