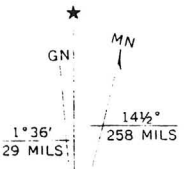

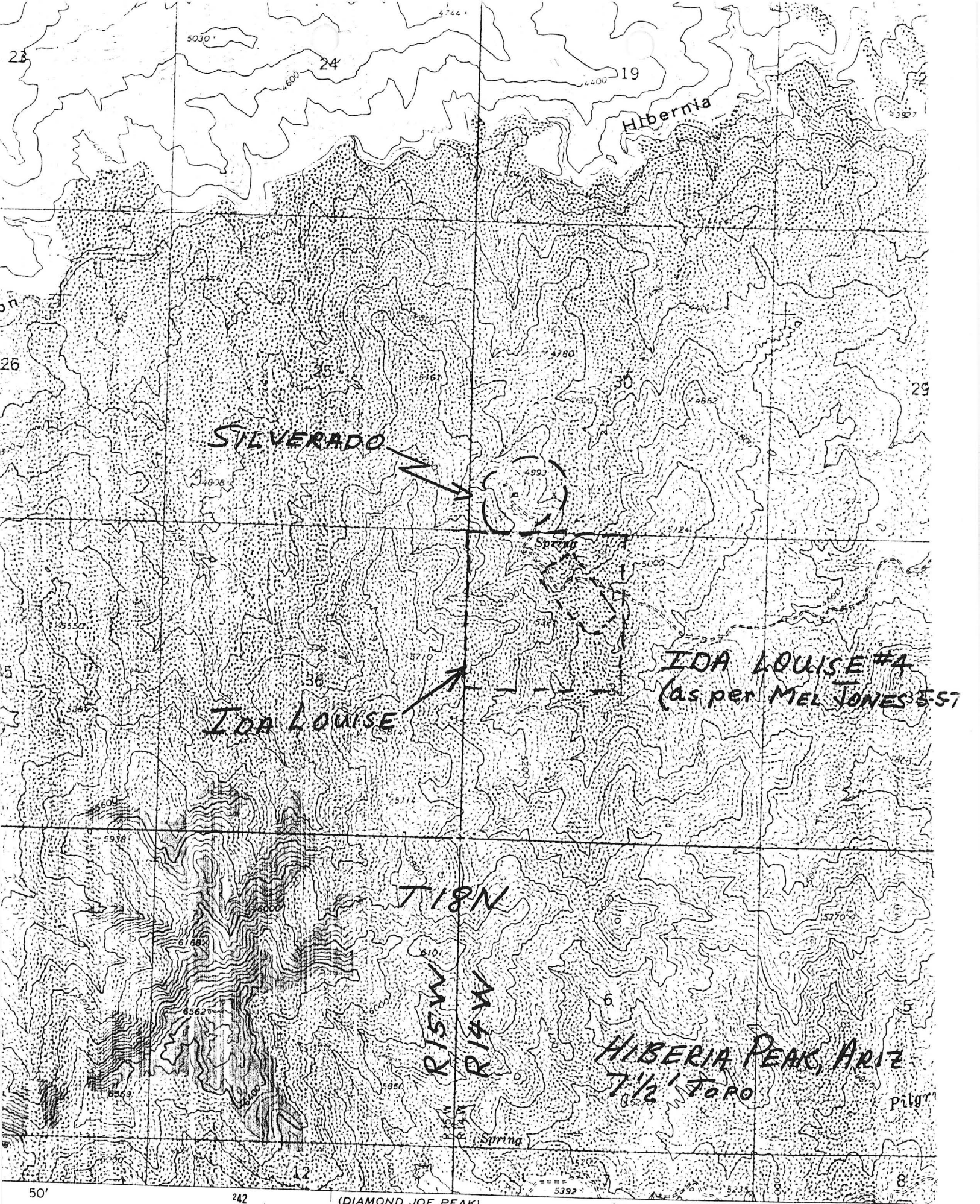

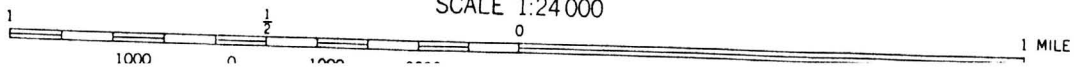

Mr. Salisbury reported he had purchased what he thought was the Silverado Mine in Hualapai Mountains, Maynard District, Mohave County, from Henry Gonzales and Ray Reyes. Mr. Salisbury reported he was given a map showing the mine was located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 31, T18N, R14W and was shown the mine which he later found out was in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 30, T18N, R14W.

He went on to report that he later found out that the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ section 30 was State school trust land with a prospecting permit issued to Cedar Minerals. He was evicted from the State trust land and assessed damages. This after he had spent approximately \$70,000 making road improvements, pads for equipment buildings, extensive shaft repairs and considerable sampling.

He subsequently took action against Messrs Gonzales and Reyes and received as compensation, title to other holdings of the men.

Mr. Salisbury has located a block of claims, the Ida Louise #1-9 in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 31, T18N, R14W. He plans geologic surveys and samples on the claim group and hopes to find a southward continuation of the silver mineralization at the silverado.
