





KAP WR 11/20/81: Eugene Disselbert reported the result of the sample taken from his Jaje Bar Group, Sec. 27, T12N R1W, Turkey Creek District, Yavapai County. He also reported he will muck the Oregon Boy shaft on the claims and sample the structure before offering the property for sale or lease.

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KAP WR 11/27/81: Mrs. Eugene Disselbret reported that her husband (Gene) and his brother Philip and Arden are going to clean out the Oregon Boy Shaft themselves. The Oregon Boy is part of the Jaje Bar Group.

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Mrs. Eugene Disselbret reported her husband and his brother are continuing to clean out the Oregon Boy shaft on the Jaje Group. KAP WR 12/11/81

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KAP WR 12/18/81: A visit was made to the Oregon Boy shaft on the Jaje Bar Group, Turkey Creek District, Yavapai County. A separate report has been written.

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KAP WR 12/25/81: Gene Disselbret reported he has completed cleaning out the Oregon Boy shaft on the Jaje Bar Group, Turkey Creek District, Yavapai County. He has sampled the vein in the shaft and drift and submitted the samples for assay. The shaft bottomed at 39 feet and the drift was run approximately 20 feet to the south on the foot wall of the vein.

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KAP WR 1/8/82: Gene Disselbret reported that the clean-out of the Oregon Boy shaft on his Jaje Bar claim has completed. He said he feels they adequately sampled the workings. They plan to continue to evaluate other old workings on the property.

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KAP WR 4/23/82: Mrs. Disselbret reported the Oregon Boy shaft on the Jaje Bar group is full of water. They have sent samples of dump material to an unknown "exotic" processor for evaluation and possible purchase.

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Date out of sequence

KAP WR 1/16/81: A Mr. Disselbret reported he has acquired a barite occurrence. He went on to report that the vein is 36-28" wide on the surface and that it was followed 28 feet down to where it pinched to 14". A sample reportedly ran 22 tr.oz/ton silver. The location of the property is not known.

KAP WR 2/13/81: Eugene Disselbret, 14819 N. 55th Ave., Glendale, AZ 85036, reported that he has a silver, lead and barite property which he calls the Jaje Bar, in Sec. 28, T12N R1W, Walker District, Yavapai County. He has cleaned out an old shaft to 28' and has done some initial sampling. Mineralization consists of galena (argentiferous) and barite. A sample of the vein material had a specific gravity of 4.2, however, the specific gravity is likely a combined result of both barite and galena. The material does not appear to have high enough barite content for economic barite markets. Additional sampling of the deposit for silver and lead values was recommended.

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KAP WR 2/27/81: Mr. Disselbrett reported that he has done additional sampling on the 27 foot shaft of his Jaje Bar Claim in the Pine Flat area, Turkey Creek District, Yavapai County. The assay results are contained in a separate report. Generally, the values for lead and silver were low enough that he plans to prospect and sample other areas on the claim group prior to doing additional work in the shaft.

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KAP WR 5/29/81: Eugene Bisselbert provided copies of assay data on the lead, silver, barite vein on the Jaje Bar Claim, Turkey Creek District, Yavapai County. He also reported that he and his brother Philip Disselbert have been in contact with Frank Russel, San Diego, CA., and that Mr. Russel plans to visit their property. They have 4 claims on veins in the same immediate area, Section 28, T12N R1W. The claims are the Jaje Bar (file), Jaje Bar #2, the Little Shoven and the Whitehead.

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Gene Disselbret reported he has "cleaned up" his claim group, the Jaje Bar, by adding some claims to make a contiguous group out of some noncontiguous parallel claims. He has added the J&J, Jaje #3, and Oregon Boy and Oregon Boy #1-#3 claims. He also exhibited a specimen of chalcocopyrite from a dump on the property and is interested in the copper potential of the claim area.

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KAP WR 9/18/81: Gene Desselbert reported the results of an assay on some hand picked chalcocopyrite bearing material from a dump on the Oregon Boy claims in his Jaje Bar Mine group. The results are 0.63 tr.oz/ton Au; 14.0 tr.oz/ton Ag and 15% Cu.

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KAP WR 11/13/81: In the company of Frank W. Russell and Eugene Disselbret a visit was made to Mr. Disselbret's Jaje Bar group of claims in the Turkey Creek District, Yavapai County. A separate report will be written.

Thanks for the letter of March 24th in regards to the mining claims in Arizona.


To further the information, I have been in contact with my brother Eugene, in Glendale, Arizona. He will be going up to the claims this week to pick up the ore samples you requested on the three veins. He will be mailing them direct to you.

As far as we can tell, there has been no milling of ore on any of the claims. The exploratory holes or shafts were dug on the veins and that amount is about enough to fill the hole back in. It looks as though they did not haul much, if any, away. My brother searched the court house records to try and find a date on these diggings, but was unable to come up with anything.

As to the difference in mine values compared to dump samples, a couple of things are possible. Are funds were very limited and we were unable to clean the hole out to get a floor sample. The sample taken was at the 30ft. mark and by using a steel rod to drive down in 5 or 6 places we found bottom at 40ft. The sample we took showed some copperoxide, azurite and chalcopryrite. The top of the dump, which came from the bottom shows chalcopryrite with some Bornite. So apparently the values will pick up with more depth. I wish we could have taken a floor sample as then one would know.

Should you want more information I will be glad to help you. Please advise.

In regards to your ad in the California Mining Journal, March issue, concerning mineral claims.

We have 2/3 interest and my brother in Glendale Arizona has 1/3 interest, in lode claims in the Bradshaw Mts. about 20 miles south of Prescott, Arizona.

We have worked on a number of the claims but are financially unable to start mining it ourselves. There are 13 total, all are connected but one which could be attached should the need arise.

The assays enclosed are from these claims, taken as honestly as possible to give true readings as to what the values are. Wrote on the assay report, is the depth and width of the vein where taken. The property appears to have 4 main veins with minor veins inbetween. The veins run about 20' off from magnetic north.

Access to claims is by maintained gravel road about 15 miles off tared road, with elevation of 5600 ft. Two of the claims cross the gravel road running about 1000 ft. northerly, and the remainder is on the south side.



On the above date a visit was made to the Oregon Boy shaft where 3 men are cleaning out the shaft. Here the shaft has been cleaned out to 34 feet. A drift to the south on the foot wall of the vein has been exposed. The drift is badly caved. A sample across the footwall of the vein where exposed in the portal to the drift shows chalcopyrite and bornite. The vein is 4½ to 5 feet wide at this point.

Plans are to continue cleaning out the shaft and the drift and to sample the vein. The work is under the direction of Philip Arden Disselbret and Gene Disselbret.

Mine: Jaje Bar

Subject: Continuation of Mine and Prospect Field Visit Data Summary for Jaje Bar Claims - November 12, 1981.

Observations and discussions are directed to the Oregon Boy, Jaje Bar and Little Shovel Claims individually.

Oregon Boy: Workings on the Oregon Boy consist of a caved inclined shaft on a vein in the Yavapai series. The vein is strongly leached at the caved collar to the shaft. Here the vein appears to strike N20°E and dips 70° - 80°W and appears to be one to three feet wide. Vein material on the dump includes pyrite, chalcopyrite and chalcocite in quartz and schist. The quartz is gray and glassy and includes some disseminated pyrite. Gene Disselbret has assayed one sample vein material collected from the dump. The result was gold, 0.63 tr.oz/ton; silver, 14.0 tr.oz/ton; and copper 15.0%. The shaft collar has sluffed to fill the shaft leaving a 12' deep pit. The shaft appears to have been inclined on the vein. The dump to the east of the shaft contains about 100 tone (\*) of material.

Jaje Bar: Workings on the Jaje Bar claim were not visited, Mr. Gene Disselbret reported he and his brother have cleaned out a shaft on a barite-agentiferous vein to a depth of 27 feet.

Little Shovel: Workings visited on the Little Shovel consist of a caved trench and shallow caved pits along 150 feet of a quartz vein which strikes N40°-50°E. The vein appears to pinch and swell from 0 to 20 inches in width. Vein material consists of a massive "ball" white quartz, limited boxwork, pieces of chlorite schist embedded in the quartz, sericite and rare pyrite. A single sample of quartz vein material was collected from material previously dug from the vein. The sample which Mr. Disselbret collected and had assayed ran 0.78 tr. oz/ton in gold.

Oregon Boy #3: To the northwest of the workings on the Little Shovel a siliceous breccia dike structure outcrops on the Oregon Boy#3 claim. The dike contains brecciated schist fragments and form a prominent outcrop which can be traced for many hundred of feet. A chip sample across the dike ran Nil gold and 0.02 tr. oz/ton.


