

your letter of Oct 24-58 inquiring about a jack pot mine located in Mohave County containing gold copper and Bismuth.

I did a lot of prospecting around and found two jack pot mines, one located out of Colorado Ariz. and one north of the Colorado river, but I was told they have no copper or Bismuth.

The partner I had in 1931 and I cleaned a sluff out at the fault on this property that I have made a sketch of, and at that time we had a party very much interested in the property and they wanted to put a 250 ton mill on the property and give us 10% royalty, but my partner wanted \$500.00 per month, but they would put no money down so the deal fell through.

There Engineer gave me a assay sheet at that time and it run \$2.85 to \$37.00 in gold and one oz in silver per ton what it will run in copper and Bismuth I do not know, it has a fair showing

in Bismuth and copper and it pan a fair showing in Bismuth

This property is located 32 miles Southeast from Kingman Ariz. in T19N R13W Sec 24 and 25

Section 25 was set aside for mineral land in the government Survey
Elevation of property 3200'

The tunnel workings is 675' and it has around 50' to 60' of backs

The vein is from 10' to 100' wide

The tunnel is just at water level
I would say that this is ideal property to do some core drilling


We will lease this property on 10% royalty with a working consideration of 40 shifts per-month
