3 claims over pegmatite dikes in schist and granite. Dikes contain coarse mica blocks, up to 2 inches in diameter, and some rare earths (Columbium-Tantalum, and Yttrium) - associated with quartz and pink feldspar. The property is developed by cuts and pits. The mica was tested in his plant at Oglesby, California, and it beneficiates satisfactorily.
