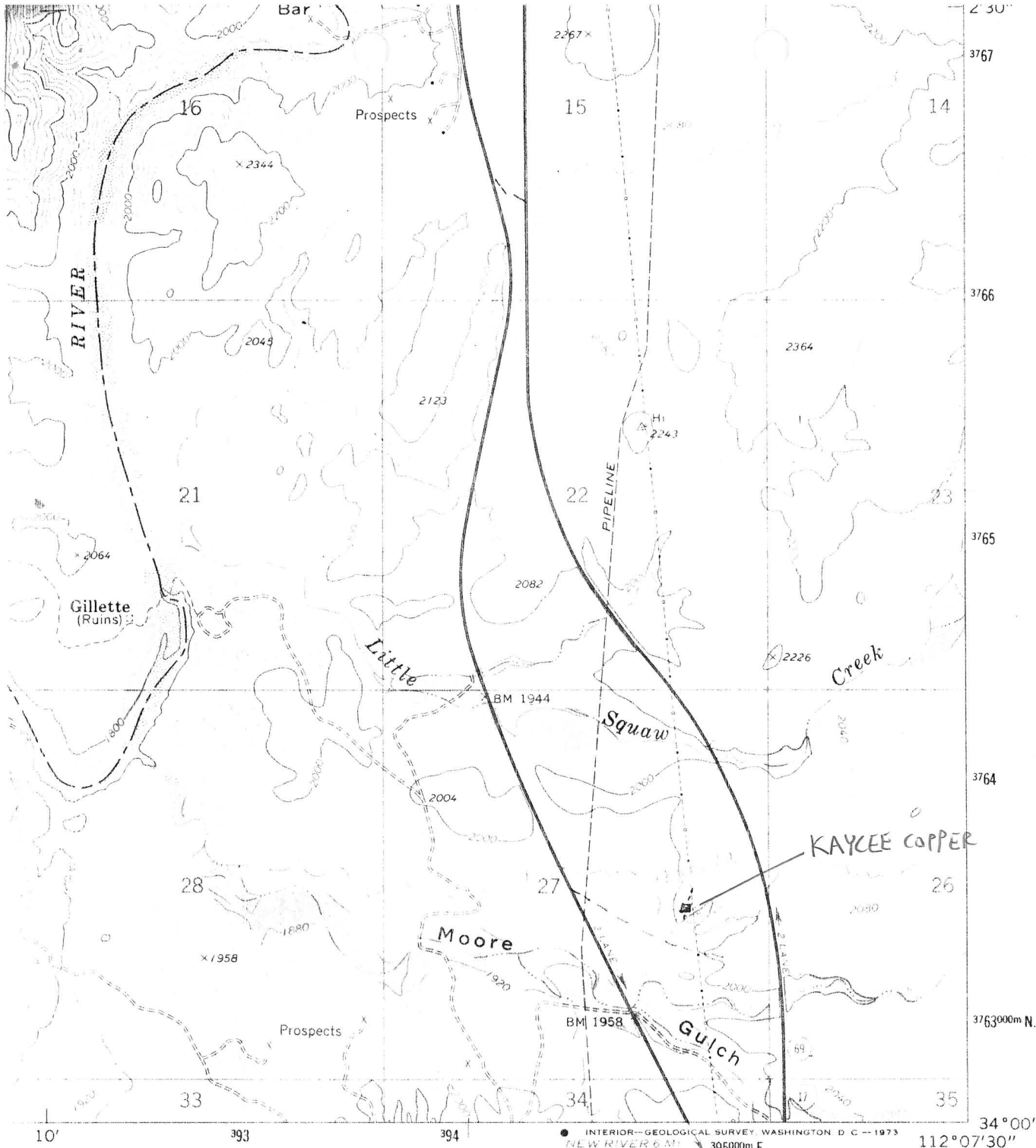

KAP WR 12/18/81: Rudy Gracey, 2930 E. Osborn, Apt. 459, Phoenix, 85016, phone 957-8529 (former Flagstaff area assayer) reported he has three claims, Kay Cee #1, #2, & #3 on a copper prospect. The property is located between the north and south bound lanes of I-17 and filed with the BLM under lead file AMC 131686. He reported an assay on the copper bearing material ran 24.7% copper. He is looking for a developer or joint venture money.

KAP WR 2/5/82: Rudy Gracey reported he feels there are two veins intersecting at his Kaycee Mine. The shaft, he explained, appears to be sunk on the inter-- section to a depth of 100 feet. Two 50' drifts are reported to be run on the vein from the shaft. He wants to find a joint venture partner to retimber the shaft collar so as to access and sample the workings.

NJN WR 2/26/82: In the company of Frank Russell, a visit was made to the Kaycee Copper Mine, Maricopa County. A separate report has been written.

NJN WR 3/5/82: Rudy Gracey visited. He reported that the assay mentioned in Ken Phillips' weekly report of 12/18/82 was of a one rock specimen weighting about 2 pounds.

CJH WR 3/9/84: Grover Heinrichs (c) called. Supplied him with information regarding the KayCee #1-3, New River District, Maricopa Co., SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 27, T8N R2E. This property is leased and has been drilled by Exxon.

MG WR 3/16/84: Mr. Grover Heinrichs informs me that an earlier report (CJH WR 3/9/84 ) stating Exxon had drilled the Kay Cee property in Maricopa Co is erroneous. The property Exxon has drilled and has apparently defined a massive copper deposit of un-reported tonnage and grade is the Kay property in the Tip Top mining district of Yavapai Co.,
