

KAP WR 10/25/85: Gordon L. Forslund, 53163 Riverview Drive, La Pine, Oregon 97739, phone (503) 536-2300 requested help in determining the legal status of his Kelly #1 claim in the NE Sec 2, T9N R15W. He had recently been notified that someone else had been doing work on his claims and that the ground was State Trust Lands. His claims were Federal, filed with the county recorder and the BLM. State prospecting permits and leases were explained. A cursory check by phone with the State Land Department indicated the entire section was held by a prospecting permit in the name of Phelps Dodge. It was explained that he likely had no rights and should contact the Land Depar tment to determine when the prospecting permit would expire. Further, if he was interested in the property he should keep close track of the permit's annual expirations dates. It was recommended he obtain a copy of Laws and Regs and read the States Land section.
