

Dear Mr. Hassell:

Enclosed is an application, required fees, and ingress/egress map for a mineral exploration permit for section 17, Township 14N, Range 19W, Mohave county, Arizona.

I have been told that this land is currently withdrawn from mineral exploration. I request the lands to be opened for mineral exploration and development for the following reasons:

- 1) The land has indications on the surface for a significant gold deposit. These include assays over 1 ppm Au from surface rock chip samples and extensive alteration of bedrock. The land has never been tested by drilling. A hardrock mining operation could provide substantial royalty revenue to the State of Arizona.
- Post-mine use of an open pit operation could provide an ideal location for 2) future expansion of the Lake Havasu city dump, which is located approximately 2-3 miles away. Also, mine waste rock and rinsed heap leached tails could provide material to the local construction industry, some of which are currently being mined from nearby gravel quarries.
