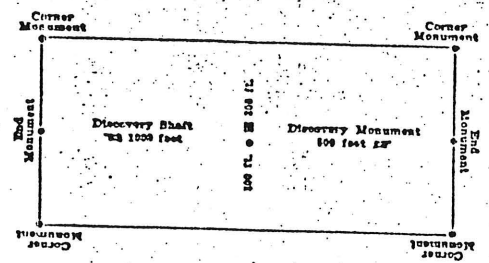

Section 4033. Such location shall be made by the locator or locators to the point of discovery of a lode or vein, or conspicuous monument of stone not less than three feet in height, or an upright post, securely fixed, projecting at least four feet above the ground, in which monument of stone shall be placed a location notice, which shall be signed by the name or names of the locator or locators.
Sec. 4030. From the time of the location of a mining claim, as above specified, the locator shall be allowed ninety days within which to do or cause to be done the following things:

- 1. To sink a discovery shaft, in the claim to a depth of at least eight feet from the lowest part of the lode or vein, and to erect a monument of stone at the center of each endline thereof.

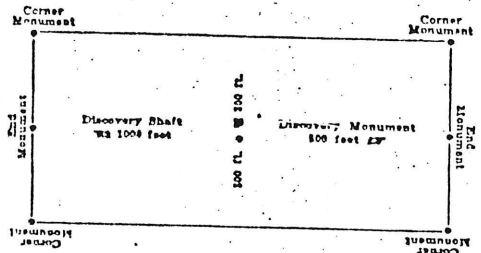

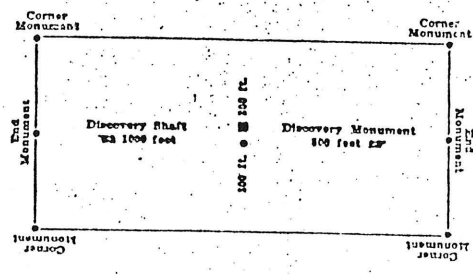

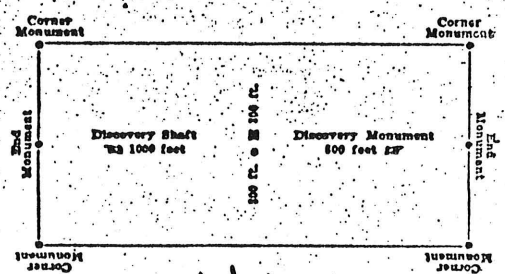
