Dear Mrs. Shanner:

In reply to your November 16th inquiry, we are enclosing a copy of a Mine Owner's Report filed with this office in 1940 by J. J. Julian and Robt. B. Shanner.

According to our records the property is in unsurveyed land within the Forest in approx. sec 19 or 30, T. 6 N., R. 5 E. The location is approximate and taken from the information given on the report blank.

If the claims were unpatented the assessment work was required for the years 1940 and 1941. Assessment work was suspended for 1942 through 1948 but we understood a Notice of Intention to Hold the claims was necessary in lieu of the assessment work. Since 1950 the usual assessment work has been required in order to keep a claim valid. If assessment work has not been done and the claims are not patented, the title merely reverts back to the United States Government.

The validity of mining claims throughout the eleven western states is very similar and inquiry in California could probably clear up any further questions.
