Manganese ores occur abundantly. Such material will some day play an important part in the reduction of certain classes of silver ores which abound in Arizona. Notable instances of their occurrence in the mines of silver ores are the Lucky Cuss, of Tombstone, and the Reymert, northwest of Florence, and others contain manganese in workable quantities.

In the Tombstone district, among the notable mines, the Tombstone Mill and Mining Co. stands prominent. It has operated a number of mines in its group, having at different times employed a large number of men, and is continuing work on a systematic scale and shows a brilliant record. Over \$8,000,000 has been produced by this company since it commenced operations, and it now owns the following mines, all of which have extensive mining machinery and hoisting works erected upon them. viz: Toughnut, North West, Lucky Cuss, West Side, Fifth Street besides other minor claims. The company also owns a 20-stamp mill.




