

MG WR 5/10/85: I identified a mineral specimen brought into the office by Mr. Warren Lazar (c). This specimen was collected from Mr. Lazar's lode claims, the Lucky group #1-6, located in the south center of Sec 3, T19S R15E, Helvetia District, Pima County. Mr. Lazar reports that there is no evidence of previous prospects or mine workings. The mineralization consists of quartz veins with magnetite (?), galena, hematite, and chalcopyrite. Mr. Lazar reports one assay of a grab sample showed approximately 100 oz silver per ton. This property is a new occurrence.

MG WR 1/23/87: Identified some quartz monzonite samples brought into office by Mr. Warren Lazar. He reports that this rock dug on his Lucky group of claims (f, Pima Co) contains native gold, copper, and lead when crushed and ground. Assays apparently run several percent in copper and lead and up to 2 ounces/ton in gold. None of these native minerals were observed with a hand lens.
