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

STATE OF ARIZONA FIELD ENGINEERS REPORT

Subject: Visit of Nov. 16

<u>Property:</u> The property, which consists of 320 claims, adjoins the northwest boundaries of the Cleopatra claims and is centered about 50 miles south of Yucca and 10 miles west of Artillery Peak. The 7 patented and 42 unpatented claims of the Cleopatra are under lease agreement to these people.

Ownership: The claims were staked recently for Chas. R. Kimes and Robt. T. England, the address of the latter being Box 517, Salinas, California.

<u>Description</u> and <u>Activity</u>: The deposit is visible in a pit in the adjoining Cleopatra property as a low-dipping tabular mass of silicified limestone. The pit has produced over 30 cars of crude ore of which 24 cars averaged 2.5% Cu and 0.12 oz. Au. At the lower end of the pit the ore dips toward the Lucky Strike property under barren cap rock and soil overburden.

At the time of visit the location work, contracted for by Ketch Billingsley, of Wickenburg, had just been completed on all the Lucky Strike claims, and a Boyle Bros. Drilling crew was drilling at 830' with objective at 2,000'. The hole is collared 600' northwest of the rim of the Cleopatra pit and is said to have encountered good mineralization. It is proposed to drill 2 other deep holes at spacings of 1000' in a northwesterly direction from hole #1. The job is being handled from a Wickenburg office at the Crestview Motel. Work is directed by Freeman Lomolino. 12 men were working besides the 2 shift per day drill crews.

A Duval engineer was examining the property on the day of this visit. Banner Mining Company made an examination several weeks ago and more recently Inspiration examined it, and Miami engineers were due next. Inspiration took a large number of samples. Bob Burns, co-lessee with Jim Tearney of the Cleopatra stated that these Inspiration samples averaged 1.83% Cu, 0.12 oz. Au, and 0.18 oz. Ag.

The property has received much attention by large companies at various times in the past and in 1917 it was the subject of an intensive promotion campaign (as the "Cleopatra Copper & Gold Mining Company") with claimed gross value of ore in sight of \$35 to 40 million. It is said that 44 diamond drill holes were put down many years ago but no data re the findings are available. The ore is a mixture of oxide and sulphide.
