Work: Several shallow cuts and a pit.

Geology: The area consists of a series of schists (which may have been derived from volcanics) domed by a coarse granitic mass. The schist complex dips 45° to the southwest and strikes northwest. The workings are in a pegmatitic quartz vein or lense which lies almost wholly within the granitic rock. It strikes about N 30° E. Netherlin states that Harrison extracted a little gold from the pit and a cut. To the west, a few miles, the schist complex plunges under volcanic ~~fill~~ ^{Flows}. Locally some andesitic lava caps the schist in patches.
