Geology: Replacement deposit in upper Coconino sandstone under the Kiabab limestone. The minerals are mainly galena and argentite with a little sphalerite and native silver. The replacement bed outcrops on both sides of a promontory near the Mogollon Rim. The deposit has been located along both sides of the promontory and is apparently 1/2 mile across at the northern end, 1/4 mile wide at the southern end and ranged from 4-8' thick. According to Mr. ~~Super~~ the ore has been found to be continuous within this zone. Some high silver values have been found. The promontory is cut by a few intermediate dikes.
