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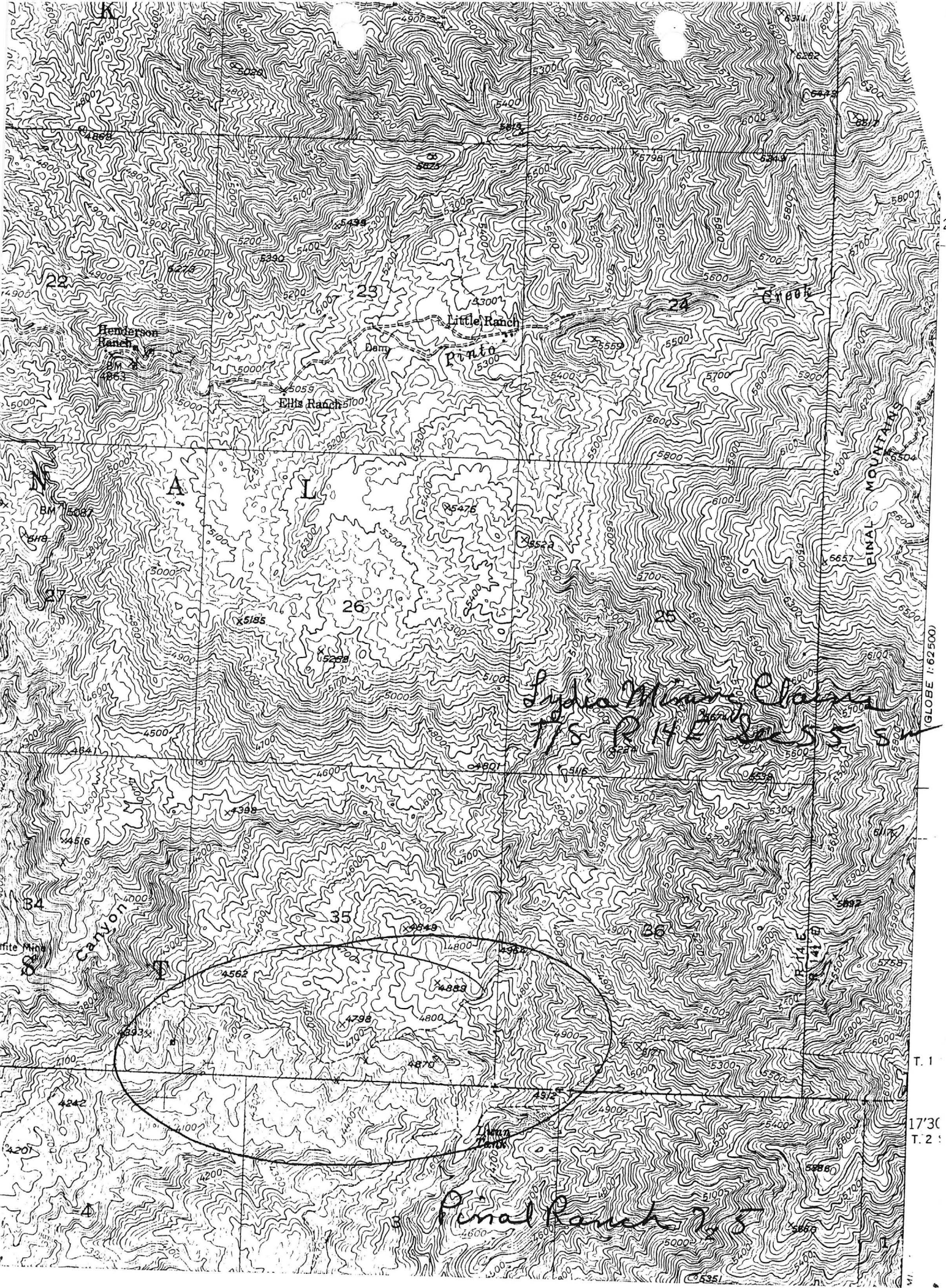

Last Will and Testament

of

P149913

NATASHA GREENLEE

I, NATASHA GREENLEE, a resident of Maricopa County, State of Arizona, do hereby make, publish and declare this my Last Will and Testament, and do hereby revoke all of my former Wills and Codicils.

FIRST:

I direct that all my just debts, funeral expenses and expenses of the administration of my estate be paid as soon after my death as practicable. I further direct that all inheritance, death and estate taxes (including interest and penalties thereon) becoming due with respect to my taxable estate by reason of my death shall be paid by my Executrix out of my residuary estate passing under this Will to the extent thereof as an expense and cost of administration of my estate. My Executrix shall have no duty or obligation to obtain reimbursement from any recipient of property not passing under this Will for any portion of such tax paid by it.

SECOND:

I am the widow of GEORGE A. GREENLEE. The objects of my bounty are my daughter, CONSTANCE ROGGE, her daughters ROSALIND ANNE DANDREA and JESSLYN SUSAN MERGEN, the daughter of my late husband DOROTHY GREENLEE WIRTH, and certain other charitable organizations named below. I bequeath to them the following gifts:

(A) I bequeath to CONSTANCE ROGGE all items of clothing and furs, all my linens, all my silver including but not limited to the complete dinner flat silverware of the "Romance of the Sea" pattern, the black bouille ebony cabinet, the carved crystal Buddha, the crystal rabbits and moon, the ivory oracle of Delphi, the two tall French ivory carved ladies on a podium, and the paintings "Portia" by Alex Cabanel, "American Cavalier" by DeAndrew, "Napoleon Battlefront" by Domingo Munoz, "The Reapers" by Dolph and "Connie" which was painted by me. I further bequeath to CONSTANCE ROGGE a life estate in my jewelry, with the exception of the diamond and amethyst cross which is hereinafter bequeathed to my granddaughter JESSLYN ROGGE MERGEN, with the direction that after her death the remainder of said jewelry be given to the children of CONSTANCE ROGGE, ROSALIND ANNE DANDREA and JESSLYN SUSAN MERGEN, to be divided between them as they shall agree. I further bequeath all my books and all my motor vehicles to CONSTANCE ROGGE.

(B) I Bequeath to ROSALIND ANNE DANDREA the Hammond organ, the black English curio cabinet with ivories, and the paintings "Reverie" by Coomins, "Reflections" by C. Vogel, "Autumn" by Benjamin Leader and "Seascape" by Unterberger.

(C) I bequeath to JESSLYN SUSAN ROGGE the tall French curio cabinet plus the ivories which now stand therein, the two French tables, my diamond and amethyst cross, the paintings "Lady Devon and Child" by Sir Thomas Lawrence, "Seascape" by Arthur Quartley, "The Pet Bird" by Ferdinand Wagner, "The Blooming Rod" painted on copper, and the small ceramic painting "Two Children".

(D) I bequeath to DOROTHY GREENLEE WIRTH the painting of her father, George A. Greenlee, and the painting "Lady

(E) I leave all my household furnishings, ivories and paintings which are not specifically mentioned above to CONSTANCE ROGGE, ROSALIND ANNE DANDREA and JESSLYN SUSAN ROGGE as they shall agree among themselves. It is my wish that any item which none of them chooses to accept be given to a worthy charity or to some individual, or individuals, in need.

(F) I bequeath the sum of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) to FRANK SHEETS LOCKHART MEMORIAL TRUTH CENTER, South Bend, Indiana.

(G) I declare that the rock and shell collection in my home is not part of my estate, but is owned by CONSTANCE ROGGE, having been given to her in 1959 by George A. Greenlee. I also declare that laboratory equipment now on the premises is not part of my estate, but that it belongs to LOCKHART MEMORIAL RESEARCH FOUNDATION, and I give my Executrix full power and authority to deal with the equipment, the same as I might do if I were living.

(H) I devise and bequeath, subject to any and all encumbrances thereon, all realty used by me as a place or places of residence and which I may own at the time of my death, together with the improvements thereon, to CONSTANCE ROGGE, if she survives me by a period of sixty (60) days.

(I) I devise and bequeath to my daughter CONSTANCE ROGGE all my right, title and interest in and to all mines and mining properties which I may own or otherwise have an interest in at the time of my death, including mining claims (patented or unpatented), royalty agreements, contracts for the sale of minerals or mining claims, leases of minerals or mining claims, and any other form of property interest having to do with minerals, mines and mining claims. I further devise and bequeath to CONSTANCE all equipment, supplies, and

accomplishing annual assessment work or used by me for any other purpose in regard to my mines and mining properties.

(J) I devise and bequeath to my daughter CONSTANCE ROGGE all my right, title and interest in and to all books and other literary material written by me, or which I assisted in writing, whether published or unpublished, including all royalties and royalty contracts with publishers, research materials, correspondence, documents and files relating to such literary material, and published and unpublished manuscripts whether complete or incomplete.

THIRD:

All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate I devise and bequeath as follows:

SIXTY PERCENT (60%) to my daughter CONSTANCE ROGGE, and

FORTY PERCENT (40%) in equal shares to my step-daughter DOROTHY GREENLEE WIRTH and my granddaughters ROSALIND ANNE DANDREA and JESSLYN SUSAN MERGEN.

If any one of my residuary legatees should predecease me, then her share shall pass to her issue by right of representation. If ROSALIND ANNE DANDREA or JESSLYN SUSAN MERGEN predecease me without leaving children, her share shall go to the other and her mother equally, or to such one of them as survives me.

FOURTH:

In the event that money or other property would be, except for this provision, distributable to a minor, then such money or other property shall be distributed by my Executrix hereinafter named to ROSALIND ANNE DANDREA for the sole and exclusive benefit of such minor until such minor attains the age of majority. The said Trustee shall, in her discretion, make distributions of capital or income directly to the minor or to her parent or other

amounts as it shall be necessary to provide adequately for such minor's health, educational and other needs. In arriving at her determination as to the minor's needs, the Trustee shall consult with the minor's parents or other guardian and with the minor when it determines the minor to have arrived at an age where he or she is able to exercise discretion in such matters.

The Trustee shall have all such powers as shall be necessary for the effective administration of each trust created herein, including but not limited to the power to invest trust funds, manage, control, lease and sell property and to determine what is principal or income.

FIFTH:

I hereby nominate and appoint my daughter CONSTANCE ROGGE Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament. My Executrix shall be permitted to qualify and act as such without bond or other security in any jurisdiction. I authorize my Executrix to sell at public or private sale, lease or mortgage, the whole or any part of my estate upon such terms and for such consideration as she or it may determine advisable, without notice and without first obtaining an order of the court therefor, but subject to such confirmation as may be required by law.

SIXTH:

In the event any legatee named herein contests the validity of this Will or aids any person who does contest this Will, then such legatee shall be excluded from any share of my estate. Such legatee's share shall then be divided among the other residuary heirs in the proportions provided for in paragraph Third.
