# MARKHAM GROUP TURKEY DISTRICT.

COPY of REPORT.

Prescott, Ariz., May 22, 1919.

Sir:-

Complying with your request on the 16th. and 17th. inst., I made a preliminary inspection of the Markham Group of Mining Claims, located at Turkey, Arizona, and I have the honor to submit to you the following gratifying results:-

The Group comprises eight claims and constitutes a favorable combination of available resources and local facilities. The predominating country rock is of a schist variety but is so metamorphosed that its original character is rather difficult to ascertain. The property is explored by means of shallow shafts, surface cuts and trenches. While these have uncovered ore persistent enough to warrant deeper exploration it has, up to the present, not been attempted. As yet the ore is small, in no place examined was over fifteen inches wide. The veins are a good size and well mineralized, have a south-west and northeast course and, so far as could be observed, are very nearly vertical. They are composed principally of calcareous spar, quartz and a small percentage of manganese. A dozen samples of ore, taken promiscuously from various places, ran as follows:-

The property is located in a rich district and from the prodigal bounty of the old Peck and other great bonanzas has a well earned celebrity. But prospects in any district only slightly developed are not readily estimated; yet the pleasing surface appearance and favorable indications, the close proximity of the De Soto and the Blue Bell mines, where deep mining offer instructive examples, justify a conclusion that the judicious expenditure of money will result also in uncovering substantial ore bodies in the Markham Property.

In conversation with several mine operators in the district I found the Markham claims to be well thought of and is believed to have a bright future. These men, who from mere prospects developed paying mines and from experience are thoroughly familiar with the mineral bearing formations

of the locality, I regard their qualified judgment of the Markham Property as very valuable. The railroad at the town of Turkey is about a half mile distant where a large, well equipped General Merchandise store is established and where first class accommodations can be obtained. There is a good supply of water in Turkey Creek and I was informed it maintains a good volume during the entire year. With a large custom smelter at Humboldt. These are important factors to be considered in connection with the property.
