

Active Mine List May 1970 - 5 men - Hyslip Stone Co. - Box 288, Prescott

Visited Hyslip plant. Not up to capacity and having some difficulties. FTJ WR 9-4-70

Active Mine List Oct. 1970 - 5 men - Hyslip Stone Co., Box 288, Prescott

Active Mine List - October 1972 Empl. 5

RRB WR 10/30/81: Visited Harley Gray Stone Co., P.O. Box 323, Paulden, Az. 636-9904 or 445-8253 in Prescott, and their quarry in Sec. 4 & 9 T19N R1E. Talked to Carl Gray to get information for Active Mines. He reported that Hudman Stone is no longer actively quarrying in the area.

NJN WR 11/27/87: Mrs. Roger Hudman reported they have sold the retail installation portion of Hudman stone (file) to Flagstone Specialties in Tucson. Hudman Stone has a new address: 9640 W. Picture Rocks Road, Tucson, AZ 85743, 622-6008. They call the quarry they operate MC Canyon Quarry, generally T19N R2E Sec 19. (file)

Mr. Frank Hyslip, owner. He is brother to a Mr. Hyslip who formerly had Hyslip Stone Co. (now a contracting firm)

Mr. Hyslip leased a stone quarry from Grand Canyon Quarries (owned by the same group of people that owns Western States Stone Co.)

My. Hyslip would not reveal production figures. Presently working approximately six. (varies) Most of the stone is sold to a Thrifty Wholesale in Prescott. Thrifty Wholesale hauls groceries to Prescott and Stone on return trip to California. Mr. Hyslip stated 95% of his production goes to California

Valley Stone, P.O. 372, Paulden, Arizona 86334, Phone 636-2235 Employees 4 - Quarry 8 miles N.E. of Drake. Local and California Markets Flagstone for decorative use local and out of state markets. General Manager - Franklyn and Barbara Hyslip.

To Valley Stone Supply in Drake. Mr. H_{yslip} stated he had more business $y_{1}^{(n)}$ than he could handle. He is still shipping to California and other points in $y_{1}^{(n)}$ Arizona. Thrifty Wholesale Grocery trucks haul the stone to California. 37^{2} He is thinking about trying to patent the claim. (36^{-2235})
