

Geology & Mineralization Ore started to make about 30 ft. before reaching shaft in main tunnel, assaying \$28.00 and improving to face of tunnel.

Ore: Positive & Probable, Ore Dumps, Tailings Shaft cut through ore shoot encountering the rich ore about 30 ft. from surface and continuing down for approximately 40 ft. The rake of the ore shoot is about 45 degrees (see sketch).




