Mining Claims

This property consists of two claims, the Montana and Montana No. 2, situate and located in the Black Hills Mining District, Yavapai County, State of Arizona, and about nine miles North West from Dewey Station toward Jerome Arizona.

This property has been located in a North Easterly and South Westerly direction, and consists of two full claims. The claims are continuous and adjoin each other on their easterly and westerly side lines.

This property is traversed by several well defined quartz-porphry veins, showing values in gold, copper, lead and silver, there has been four openings made on this property for exploration purposes, and in each instance showing good values running from \$10.00 per ton to \$35.00 per ton in gold with silver predominance.

The openings referred to are three incline shafts and one tunnel with open cut face or front of about twenty-five feet and running back into the mountain a distance of approximately ninety feet, this tunnel is about 5-1/2 by 6-1/2 in the clear. The shafts are sunk to a depth of about fifteen feet and a good showing is found in each thereof.

All of the veins referred to run parallel to the main vein and if explored and developed should materially aid to the value of this property. One opening on this property, an incline shaft showing values from \$35.00 to \$75.00.

The high grade ore vein in this shaft is about fifteen inches wide and runs as stated \$75.00 per ton.

ROAD. This property is situate about six miles off the DEWEY and JEROME highway, and has a very good road leading up to the base of the mountain, and a distance of about one-fourth mile to the claims in the mountain.

Also this property is situate about twenty-five miles from the Clarkdale Smelter with a good road thereto.

WATER. This property adjoins thirteen patented claims owned by a New York syndicate, they have a shaft one thousand feet deep from which an abundance of water is available, and the water level in this district is estimated at about sixty feet in depth.

WOOD AND FUEL. This property is located at an altitude of about five thousand feet, and there is found plenty of wood for fuel and camp purposes.

WILD GAME. Is very plentiful, bear, deer and on down to the smaller animals.

The recorded location of this property is filed in the office of the County Recorder of Yavapai County, State of Arizona, and for a more full and complete description thereof, reference to said records is hereby made and made a part hereof.

All annual assessment work as required by the State and Federal laws have been fully complied with.

MR. JOHN P. HOLMAN is the sole owner of this property, and there is no liens or other encumbrances thereon.

CLIMATE. The climate in this region is splendid in summer, with slight showers; in the winter, some fall of snow, but is protected from the north by the mountain and no severe weather is to be had.

CAMP-SITE. There are several ideal camp-sites to be obtained on the property, on the mountain, and at the base of mountain.

This property has marked potential possibilities, and from the assay showing and little development now having been done on the property, if taken together with proper handling and treatment of ores it would no doubt develop into a paying property.
