about 8:30 AM. The property is located near a small saddle between Bumble Bee and the Howard Silver Mine. It can be reached from the west by hiking up a steep hillside about 2600 feet to the claims. There is no defined trail.

There are about 120 feet of adit and a 30 foot prospect pit on a vein that strikes ESE and dips steeply to the north. The vein has been exposed in the adit, on strike along the hill and on the other side of the saddle from the adit. The vein ranges from six inches to as much as two feet in thickness and is reported to carry values in gold and silver. Vein material is an iron stained quartz with some gossan. In spots chalcopyrite can be seen encapsulated in quartz.

Considering the work done on the property and its location the following program is recommended to justify further work and/or holding the claim:

The property should be surveyed, mapped and sampled by a mining engineer or geologist and recommendations made based on this information. I would estimate that the work could all be done in one day pending results of the assaying.
