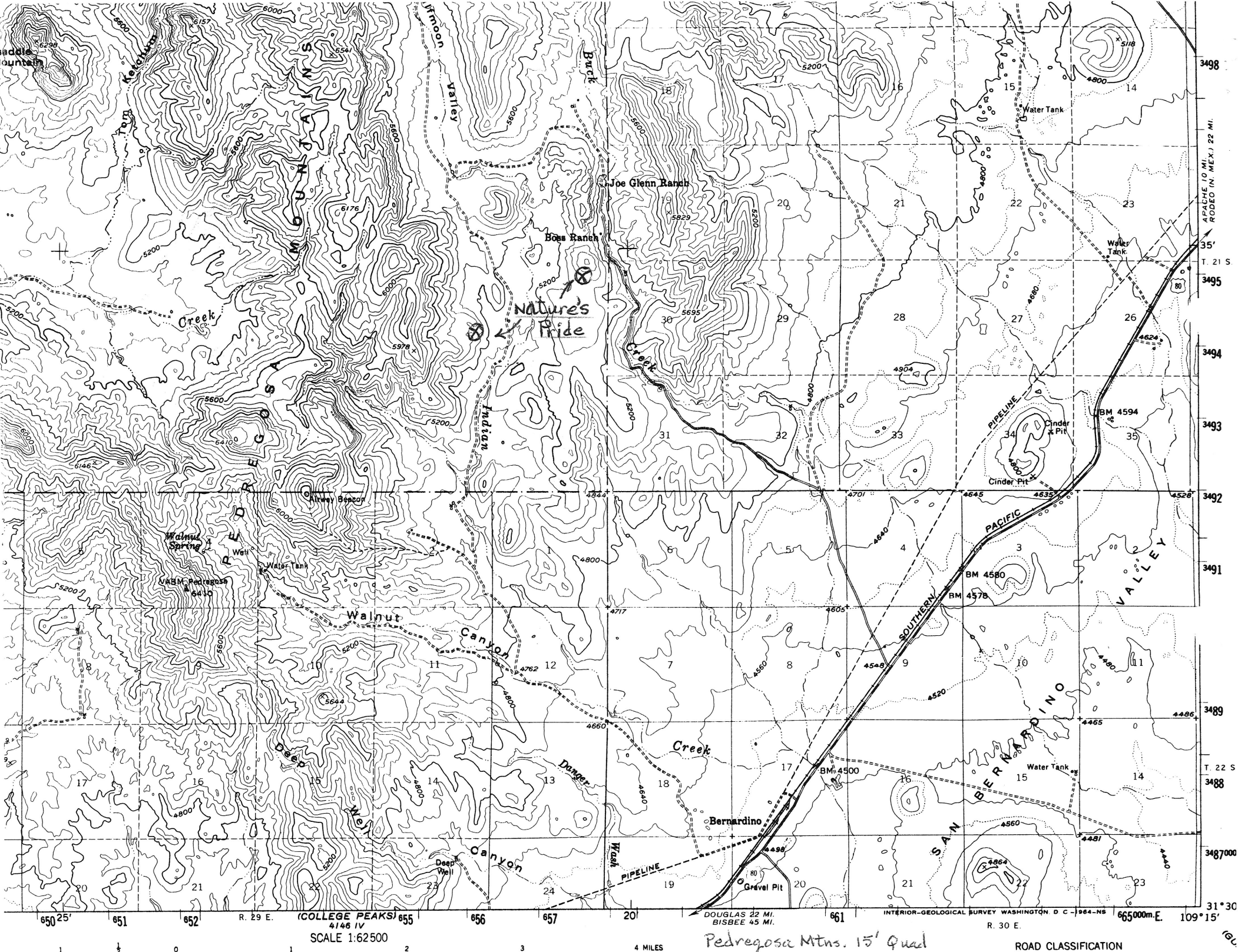

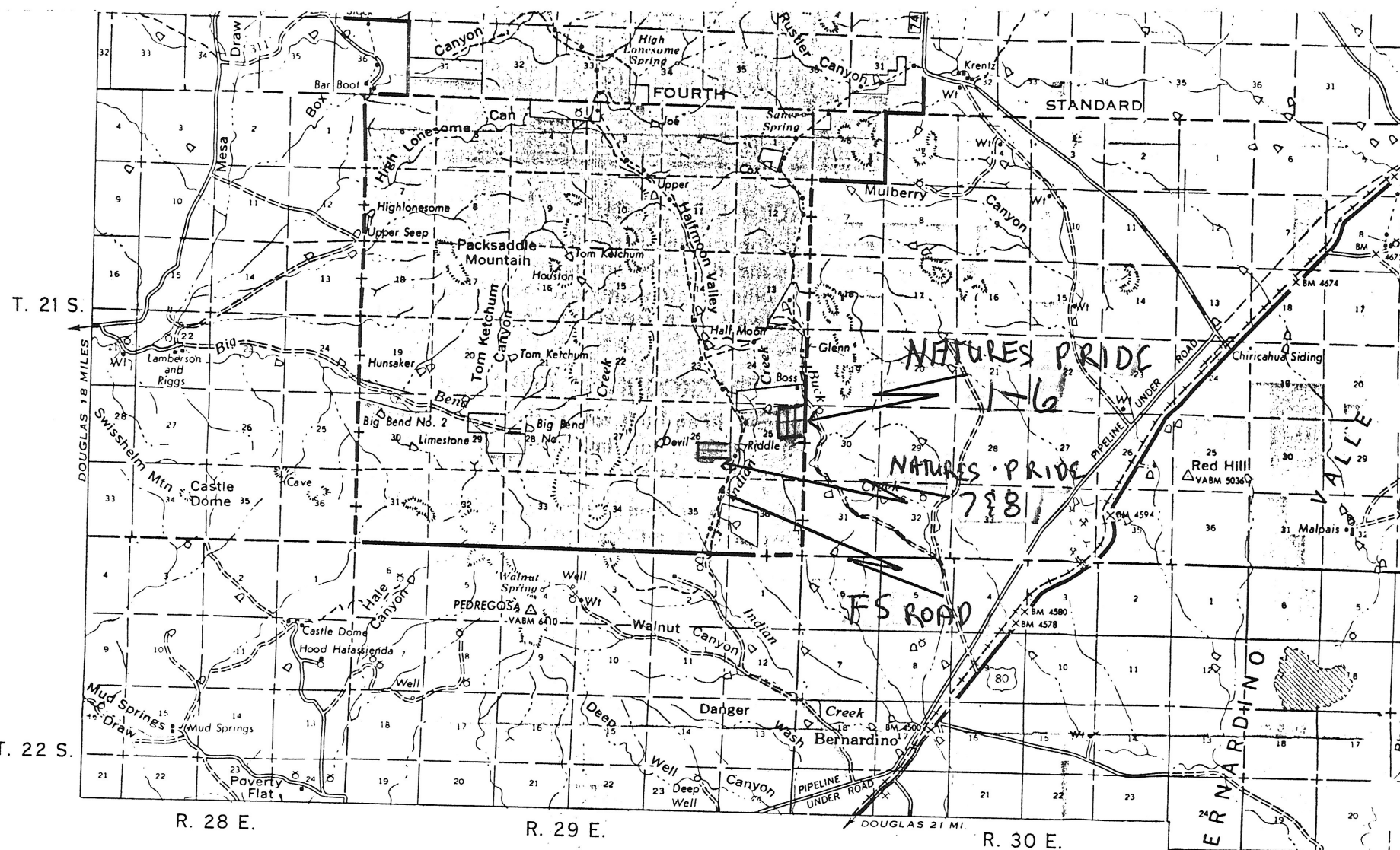

COCHISE COUNTY

MG WR 1/18/85: Mr. Jim Vaugh (c) reports he dropped the Nature's Pride property in Cochise County. He said that although more than 10,000,000 tons of gray pumice have been identified on the property, he could not develop a market.

MG WR 5/27/88: Visited Natures Pride pumice deposit, Cochise County. This property, in the Pedrogosa Mountains, is centered on Indian Creek and between Indian Creek and Buck Creek. Although the Natures Pride claims were staked for pumice, I believe most of the rock is rhyolite. There may be some tuff, and locally some outcrops appeared pumiceous.
