He would like to receive some sampling advice and have the general geology at the Nevada claim explained to him. '

NJN WR 7/9/82: Production data was received from the Bureau of Geology and Mineral Technology for the Nevada, Surprise, etc. Claim Group, Yavapai County. Production during 1941-1942 was 64 tons from which 1,640 oz Ag and 75 oz. Au was recovered.

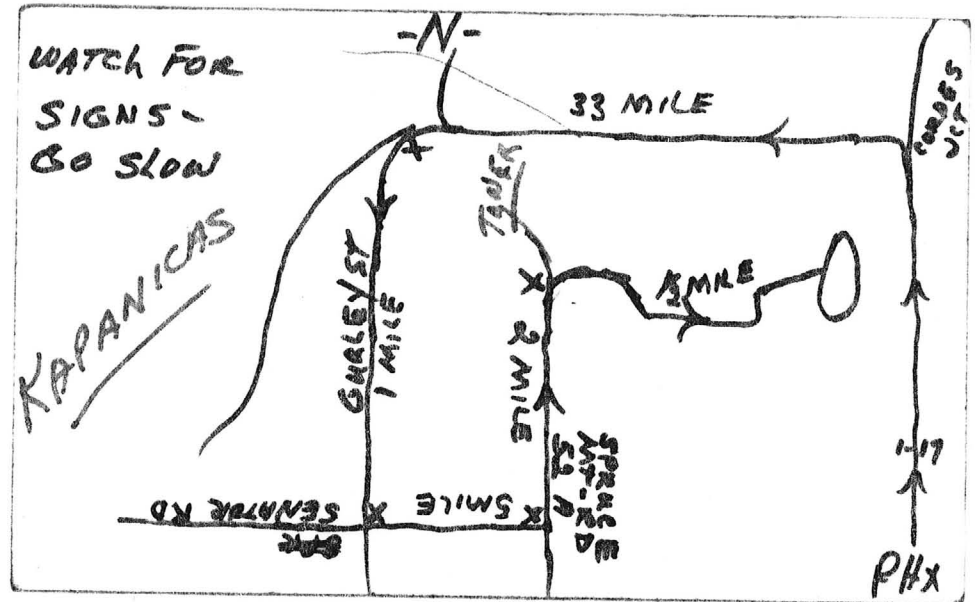
