Dewan Circle, Mesa, Arizona 85208, 981-5402 reports that CR Nolton, dba KTK Ventures, P O Box 642, Mayer, Arizona 86333, is reprocessing dumps at the New Jersey (file) Yavapai County. The operation consists of crushing the material and running it over a carpeted sluice to produce about a barrel of concentrates a day. The concentrates contain free gold and gold in sulfides. Provided assistance on selling their concentrate, in getting their concentrate reconcentrated and a dore produced, and suggestions on how and where to market their dore.

NJN WR 8/26/88: Lily Russel reported that production by KTK Ventures at the New Jersey (file) Yavapai County to date has totaled 16.4 oz Au and approximately 33 oz contained in concentrates in process.
