Subject: General Description & Present Status.

Location, Ownership, etc.:

✓ This unpatented property known as New Yorker #1, #2, and #3 claims is owned by N.T. Zuver of Salome and leased to L.C. Huthmacher, Box 92, Wenden. They are reached by nine miles of graded road ~~to~~ Southward from Salome and are about one mile North of the Harqua Hala Mine. They are in the central part of Twp. 4 N, R13W. The workings are just North of the Golden Eagle workings, operated by Mr. Zuver.

Geology & Development:

The principal workings are on an almost flat surface cut from quartz monzonite porphyry or similar rock. This formation has been fractured and altered along some fissuring and mineralized with copper and iron sulphides and quartz. Some pits and a vertical shaft show copper silicate and oxide minerals. The shaft is reputed to be about 100 feet deep with water standing at about 45 feet. At about 37 feet, there is supposed to be a level with two drifts 10 feet and 30 feet long. In one of these and in the shaft, there is said to be quite a little iron pyrite. Quite a little copper sulphate is said to show on this level over an area about 20 feet in diameter. Mr. Huthmacher would like someone to take over his lease from him.
