Northwest Inspiration Copper Company

The property of the Northwest Inspiration Copper Company consists of twenty-six contiguous mining claims, approximately five hundred acres of well mineralized ground located in the Globe-Miami mining district. This property formerly known as the Houston-Rose property lies in part in direct contact with the Inspiration Consolidated Copper Company's ground, on the south and southeast. To the southeast about four thousand feet distant lies the Miami Copper Company's mine—to the east only a few hundred feet away lies the famous Black Warrior mine. 

has driven a cross-cut drift three hundred and eighty feet on a three hundred foot level; this drift has penetrated through iron sulphides for more than one hundred feet which assays one and a half to two per cent copper. The face of this drift is in a formation identical with that which accompanies the ore bodies in the Black Warrior mine. The management expects to encounter a large body of high grade ore in this drift. It is conceded by many who are familiar with the surrounding conditions that the Northwest Inspiration Copper Company will soon become a producing and paying mine.

A few years ago the investing public were invited to participate in the development of the Miami Copper Company's ground. Those who were fortunate enough to purchase stock now draw handsome dividends. Greater opportunities were afforded by the Inspiration Consolidated Copper Company.
