OHIO GIANT MINE YUMA COUNTY

Ohio Giant Mine is now being open pitted by the Jim and Bob Mining Co., P.O. Box 1272, Parker. Met Mr. Bob White who told me they had started to work last October and had started the first batch to leaching last Sunday, June 7. He has 5 men working. He says the ore is running about 1.22% copper but they have to haul water from the Bill Williams River about 14 miles. Suggested they try some method of agitating the leach ore. GW WR 6-12-70

The Jim & Bob Mining Co. is operated by Jim Evers and Bob White on the old Ohio Giant property. On June 7, 1970 they began vat leaching 700 tons of copper ore said to assay 1.22%. Presently they haul water from the Bill Williams River but will drill a well on the property later this summer. GW QR 7-1-70

The Jim & Bob Mining Co. is temporarily down while drilling for water. GW WR 10-16-70

Went to Parker and called Robert White of Jim & Bob Mining Co. He said they were still not in continuous production at the Ohio Giant, due mainly to the lack of water. The wells do not supply enough and it has to be supplemented by hauling from the Bill Williams river, about 14 miles. GW WR 2-12-71

Active Mine List October 1970 - 5 men - Rpbert White, supt. P.O. Box 1272, Parker.

Jim and Bob Mining Co. of Parker continue to operate the old Ohio Giant property 12 miles east of Parker on a limited basis due to the lack of water. It is reported that Fortune-Channel Mines, Vancouver, B. C. will take over this operation if more ore reserves can be found in the vicinity. GW QR 4-8-71

Went on to the Ohio Giant where there was no activity however there was a truck mounted drill-rig with the mast down sitting above the mine face. The crushing, screening and leaching equipment installed about a year ago by the Jim & Bob Mining Co. were on the ground. Mr. Heizer confirmed the rumor heard in Salome concerning the sell-out by Jim & Bob and stated they were now operating the Gold Belt property about 20 miles southwest of Aguila. GW WR 6-14-71

Both the Northstar and the Ohio Giant copper properties were closed during the period. $_{\mbox{GW}}$ $_{\mbox{QR}}$ 9/71


