Number of Claims: About 100 unpat. claims on Federal land plus 320 acres of patented homestead.

Owners:

- (1) Dave Owen, owner of 1/2 Section (320 acres) of patented land (Desert Homesite) with mineral rights.
- (2) Kerr-McGee Oil Industries, Inc., 1637 E. 18th St., Tucson, holders of about 100 unpatented claims adjacent to (1).

Lessees: Kerr-McGee Oil Industries, Inc. leasing the 320 acres of patented mineral land from Dave Owen.

Principal Minerals: Copper ore.

Present Mining Activity: Rotary and diamond drilling on contract to F.C.M. Drilling Service, Flagstaff, Ariz. 1 rig working, alternating between rotary and diamond. Work was started only a few weeks ago.
