The holders of the prospecting permit on State Trust Land have excavated a single pit in gravels on Pecham Wash. Excavation to bedrock. Approximately four yards of gravels yielded 0.088 troy ounces of free gold. Gravels were processed in a small "Placer King" tromell and box. Water was hauled. The permit holders are investigating the availability of water from an old dug well at Pecham Camp.

It was noted that the sample pit bottom was washed clean and the "bedrock" was rather soft decomposed granitic rocks with more or less caliche cement. Experience has shown such "bedrock" to contain some placer gold in other parts of the district.

Thickness of gravels at the sample site varied from 1 - 2½ feet deep. Plus 3 inch material was less than 25% of the gravels.
