Subject: Interview with Raymond Perry.

Claims: 1 unpatented

Location:  $6\frac{1}{2}$  miles north of Brenda and 1 mile west of the Black Beauty Mine.

Owner: Raymond Perry, Star Rt. 1, Box 27, Salome, Arizona

Work: Shallow trenches and pits.

Geology: According to Mr. Perry the chrysoprase occurs in a volcanic rock which he believes is rhyolite. The mineral is in a stringer load, or stockwork, and varies from  $1/4$  inch up to 4 inches in thickness. The mining has to be done without shooting so as to prevent shattering and is therefore slow.

Mr. Perry stated that he had sold around \$2000. worth of chrysoprase in the past couple of years. At present he is doing assessment work for two people and hopes to finish this by October.
