Campbell

Makes 115,000 bricks per day. Delivered price is about \$11.50 per ton which gives an idea of what can be paid for clay. Some is bought for 5¢ per ton.

The bricks weigh approximately 3,045 lbs. per 1,000.

They use some west coast clays @ \$2 to \$10 per ton plus about \$10 freight to Phoenix, for blending with some kinds of brick. They are clays of known, reliable quality.

They mine one clay from 30 miles south of Tucson near Pantano Wash. Have tandem hopper trucks for hauling.

They are always interested in Arizona clays.
