

PRINCESS ELENA CLAIMS (file) 1969 PTNAL COUNTY

42 Claims about 14 miles east and north of Florence, Ariz. on Mineral Mtn. and have been assayed at about 67.2% lead with minor amounts of zinc, sulphur, and manganese. It is also reported that assays yielded 2.6 oz of silver per ton and a trace of gold. Claims have been filed in the name of Mesa Mining and Development Co. Mesa Mining apparently has interest in selling the claims out and retaining royalty figures rather than developing the property themselves. (Ariz. Natural Resource Services 5/15/69)
