


"The Rawhide Mine is developed numerous adits, shafts and pits on tow parallel fault zones: 174/82NE; 179/89NE. The faults are separated by 35 to 50 feet of intensely brecciated and altered material. The host rocks are Paleozoic (?) limestones. The mineralization is contained in highly fractured and altered zone with calcite, quartz, hematite and limonite. Primary mineralization was sulfide and ore appears to be supergene enriched material."4



Townsend reported that Clyde Kopher, of Wikieup, was doing assessment work at the Rawhide Mine. Kopher plans to spend \$1000 on assessment work which will consists of driving a raise and a drift in the old mine. 3 men are employed.
