RED BULL # 1-10

LA PAZ COUNTY

NJN WR 7/15/83: Bob Westbrook reported that Eugene Bender and Ross Hefner, P O Box 1696, Wickenburg, Arizona 85358, have staked the Red Bull #1-10 claims on old workings unknown to the Department records or topo maps. The workings consist of one deep shaft plus as many as 25 miscellaneous adits and prospects. These are on a red hematite structure which may contain significant gold and silver mineralization.
