

GAM/WR 2/10/79 - Was in to discuss telluride ore and sulfide ore at his property the Rochester which consists of 4 claims, the Rememberence and the Bulldog 1, 2 & 3. His grandfather worked the property and wrote a report in which he stated that there was both gold telluride and sulfide ore at the property. Mr. Boggs attended one of the Mineral Resources Conferences, Gold Prospecting and got the impression that you could not have telluride and sulfide ore in the same ore body and here was the report written by his grandfather saying you could have both types of ore. The problem was resolved to his satisfaction. His grandfather's report stated that they left 100 tons of ore stockpiled on the property and Mr. Boggs thinks that the ore is still there.
