

The property of the Remington Non Metallic Mining Company consisting of 240 acres, is located in the Walnut Grove Mining district, 38 miles south of Prescott, Arizona, and east of Kirkland Jct. 8 miles which make it 13 miles from railroad.

The owner of the property is Robert MacDonald Robertson, of Lois Hotel, Oakland, California also of Prescott Ariz.

One can drive to the property by Auto going over the Oiled Highway to Kirkland and then over a good graveled road to the deposit which is on Milk Creek. A new road could be made to the property which will cut off approximately 4 miles distance to Kirkland.

The topography is gentle to rough, and only rough where the side washes cut out from Milk Creek. These side washes expose the pumic all the way from Milk Creek on both sides of the wash for several hundred feet back, as well as several thousand feet along the walls of Milk Creek.

The pumic is a fine grain pure white variety, and will average 10 feet thick. It is soft and breaks out freely. There is about 4 feet of decomposed over burden which could be scrapped off cheaply exposing clean pumice for mining by the cheapest methods. Trucks can be driven to the lower edge of the deposit, so mining and loading should not cost more than 20 to 25 cents per ton.

The deposit is so well exposed by nature that several working faces can be opened at once, and so extensive that it will take generations to work it out.
