

Sampled Area and Hill with Quartz veins.





WE GW 9/26/77: Mr. Parsons, Quartzsite, came in to discuss his Renegade gold property, 23 mines SW of Quartzsite. He has a 6" vein of gold-quartz which he says has 3-4 oz. gold/ton and 16 oz. silver. His property is in Section 7, T2N R17W in the Kofa Game Range.

RRB WR 5/6/83: Visited the Renegade Mine on the Kofa Game Range with Bill Menkhus and Quint Hill - separate report.

HM WR 1/9/88: Detective Ozlanski, Mesa Police Dept. was provided information on platinum in Arizona. The police department is investigating a case in which two 1000 oz supposedly platinum bars were stolen from a Mr. Quinton Hill. Mr. Hill claims to have produced the platinum from the Renegade Mine, La Paz County. The bars were probably produced from base metal amalgam but since Mr. Hill still has a third bar, an invitation to analyse the metal on the ADMMR spectrograph was extended.

Subject: Property visit

On this date at the request of and in the company of Bill Menkhus 6131 N. 16th St., Phoenix, Arizona 85016, Phone: 266-5514, I visited the Renegade Mine. We were joined by Quint Hill who is familiar with the property and an assistant. It is reportedly owned by W. T. Beard, 10751 Meade Drive, Sun City, AZ 85351, Phone: 933-4518. There are numerous quartz veins striking generally SW-NE and from 2 to 12" in width cutting sediments which show some local metamorphism. The quartz is iron stained and contains varying amounts of dark brown calcite. Some of the old workings are still accessible.

Mr. Hill's assistant and I descended a shaft about 60 feet and took a 5 gal. composite sample of vein material from several places in the rib and back and lying loose on the floor.

Mr. Menkhus and Mr. Hill took several samples of placer and vein material from cuts and various piles about the property.

Mr. Hill kept us well entertained with stories of the mine's history, difficulties both physical and legal and how between the Mafia and the Platinum Cartel he was forced out of business. He gave me a piece of "platinum ore" that he picked up and also some "pyrite cubes" that he picked out of one of the veins. Both are calcite. He also says that there is a tin deposit nearby that runs 60% tin but that the tin cartel won't let him mine it.

The samples were taken to Mr. Hill's place in Quartzsite and the placer material was fed to a Gardner-Denver ore processor that still had the trommel full of material from the last run. A fantastic amount of gold was recovered in nugget form. The hard rock material was run through a roll crusher to approximately $-\frac{1}{2}$ " and was then fed to the Gardner-Denver ore processor without cleaning it out between runs and more gold was recovered in nugget form. I did not remain for the processing of all of the samples.

A cut of the sample from the shaft was made (by grabbing hand fulls after it was crushed) to be send to the assayer. A very poor sampling technique but it should be adequate judging by the amount of gold floating around.

The strange part was that I could never see any gold in any of this until it was run through the ore processor.

I suggest that Mr. Menkhus should hire an independent mining engineer to sample and evaluate the property with no assistance from the owner or Mr. Hill. The property just may be able to stand on its own if properly evaluated and developed.




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RENEGADE PROPERTIES
