

REPORT ON THE HERMAN DEITLEFF
PROPERTY

The Herman Deitleff property consists of two claims lying East and West on a continuation of the San Francisco vein, which is the south vein of the Crown Point Mining Company, formerly known as the Ray Silver Lead.

The San Francisco vein is open for about three hundred feet, all in shipping ore. The Deitleff vein is open in five different openings, very shallow, all carrying values, some of them up to \$40 per ton. The vein is four feet wide and very persistent the length of two claims.

The Crown Point, lying to the West, comprising eight claims, has at least twenty openings, all in shipping ore.

The formation is heavy lime cut with North-South faults and East-West fissures. The ore occurs in the fissures and sometimes partially on the bedding planes.
