MG WR 8/27/82: Visited the Ricketts Mine in Sections 23 & 24, T18S R19E, Cochise County. There is no sign of recent activity at this property. The four patented claims, comprising 82.644 acres, are Richetts 1, Ricketts 2, Ricketts 3 and Ricketts 4. All four claims are owned by the Phelps Dodge Corp. The surrounding property in Sec. 23 & 24 appears to be covered by the Whet group of unpatented lode claims owned by Kerr McGee Resources.

Visit by field engineer, information from Mr. George Peverill.

Location:

S24# T18S R19E, the east slope of the Whetstone Mts. About $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles north of the Lone Star.

This mine may be located under another name. According to Mr. Peverill, tungsten and uranium have been mined. He stated that it was owned by Mr. O. B. Taylor of Benson, and that Mr. Taylor was planning on doing some work soon.

Considerable material has been moved from an open pit on the side of the mountain. This can be seen from the highway near Benson. The engineer so no signs of activity that would indicate work had been resumed.
