Principal Minerals: Copper (oxidized on surface) - (Cuprite)
(Azurite)
(Chalcopyrite)

Ore Values: Copper - 9% in 2 ft. vein.

Proposed Mining Activity:

- (1) Mix siliceous ore with the chalcopyrite to reduce smelter chgs.
- (2) Leach surface oxidized ores.
- (3) Explore to uncover vein or veins.
- (4) Mine out surface ore first. Run adit into hill later.
