The property is 4 miles west of U.S. Highway 93 on the Signal Road, 12 miles east of Bland's ranch. It is an old property that was relocated in 1956 by Robert T. Evans of Wickieup.

The country rock is granite-gneiss. The vein is a shear zone carrying quartz, lead, zinc, silver and gold. It is about theee feet wide, strikes N $10^{\rm O}$ E and dips $80^{\rm O}$ W.

Ore shows cerrusite, oxidized zinc minerals and chalcopyrite casts. Grade is unknown. Some manganese stain is evident.

There are several shallow shafts on the property and some short drifts. The original work was done many years ago.
