ROPER CLAIMS

YUMA COUNTY ELLSWORTH DISTRICT

Around the Rio del Monte, Darland and Matthews Claims (Little Harquahala Mtns 4-5 miles SW of Salome.

Conference with W. D. Roper, at the Rio del Monte 2/14/67.

Roper said that he now has laid out about 720 Claims including those at the Rio del Monte and A. Matthews Claims with whose owners he has a working agreement only. The work has been done on the Roper Claims by means of trenches pits and drill holes, many claims under the provisions of the State Location Law (up to 10 claims, etc.). He has had one drill operating for several months, sinking location holes up to 105-110 feet deep. Roper said he would end up spending roughly \$50,000. He claims that he has found a copper-bearing belt west of the Range that lies W of the Rio del Monte about 1 to $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles. The belt is reportedly extensive along the strike.

Roper has a machine for trenching.
