



Subject: New Item---Source of Information-- D. F. Gordon, Tombstone, Ariz.

Location In Chiricahua Mts.---exact location not mentioned. Needs road to property.

Owners ✓ Robert Keenan, Box 407, Tombstone, Ariz. --- 1/2 interest
D. F. Gordon, Box 516, Tombstone, Ariz. ---- 1/2 interest

Operators same as above.

Metals Mined Antimony in form of Stibnite(Sb_2O_3). Very high grade ore.

Men Employed Operators themselves working on the property.

Production Rate Varied and indeterminate.

Marketing Facilities Trying to obtain a good market for the ore. A. S. & R. Co., at Tucson will buy the ore at 24 cents per lb. Owners think it should bring a higher price.

Ore Values Ore is Stibnite, and runs up to 60 % in Antimony, with 20 oz. of Silver and .08 oz. in Gold. Ore also contains small amounts of As, S, Pb, Zn, & Cu.

Present Operations Mining ore and stockpiling same until a road is built into the property. Owners now have a stockpile of 50 tons of ore ready for shipping.

Old Workings One shaft 48 ft. deep on the property. One shaft depth not known.

Geology Vein is 7 to 8 ft. wide.

Special Difficulties Owners would like to find a good market for this ore. The A. S. & R. Co. at Tucson will pay them 24 cents a pound for the Antimony. Owners think this ore should bring a higher price, as the market price is above 45 cents per lb. Owners also need to build a road into the property.
