

Field Engineer's personal visit and information from D. T. Rushby.

Location. Go 49 miles on the Tucson-Ajo road west towards Sells. Turn left (south) and drive 4.9 miles on rough dirt road. Turn left (east) and drive 0.7 miles to mine.

No. of Claims. 1 unpatented claim - located Jan. 9, 1954.

Owner. Dewitt T. Rushby, Box 322, Sells, Ariz. (bought out E. L. Hicklin, former partner)

Operator. Same as above.

Principal Metals and Minerals. Tungsten ore in the form of scheelite.

No. of Men Employed - 1 (Mr. Rushby).

Production Rate. None at present. Operator is doing exploration work, stockpiling the ore obtained in exploration work.

Geology. Tungsten ore found in fissures and shear zones in quartzite.

Ore Values. Operator reports 1.5 % tungsten ore after sorting.

Ore in Sight and Probable Ore. No ore in sight; probable ore limited. Has 5 tons stockpiled, ore reported to run 1-1/2%.

Milling Facilities. No mill on property. Ore must be trucked to a custom mill for treatment.

Present Mine Workings. 1 location cut, 30 ft. long by 15 ft. wide by 10 ft. deep.

Past Production. Operator reports 30 tons of tungsten ore milled at the Fernstrom Mill at Arivaca. Last ore shipments made in November, 1954.

Present Operations. Operator doing exploration work, stockpiling the ore produced from this exploration work. Operator has no air compressor, but is using hand steel for drilling.

Proposed Plans. Operator plans on installing air compressor in the near future and to continue exploration work.

Remarks. (1) Owner, Mr. Dewitt T. Rushby, also owns the Delilah claim, adjoining the Birthday.

(2) Prospects for developing any large tonnage of ore seems slight on account of the narrow and scattered ore fissures in the quartzite rock.
