cut 4x20 ft., 10 ft. long.

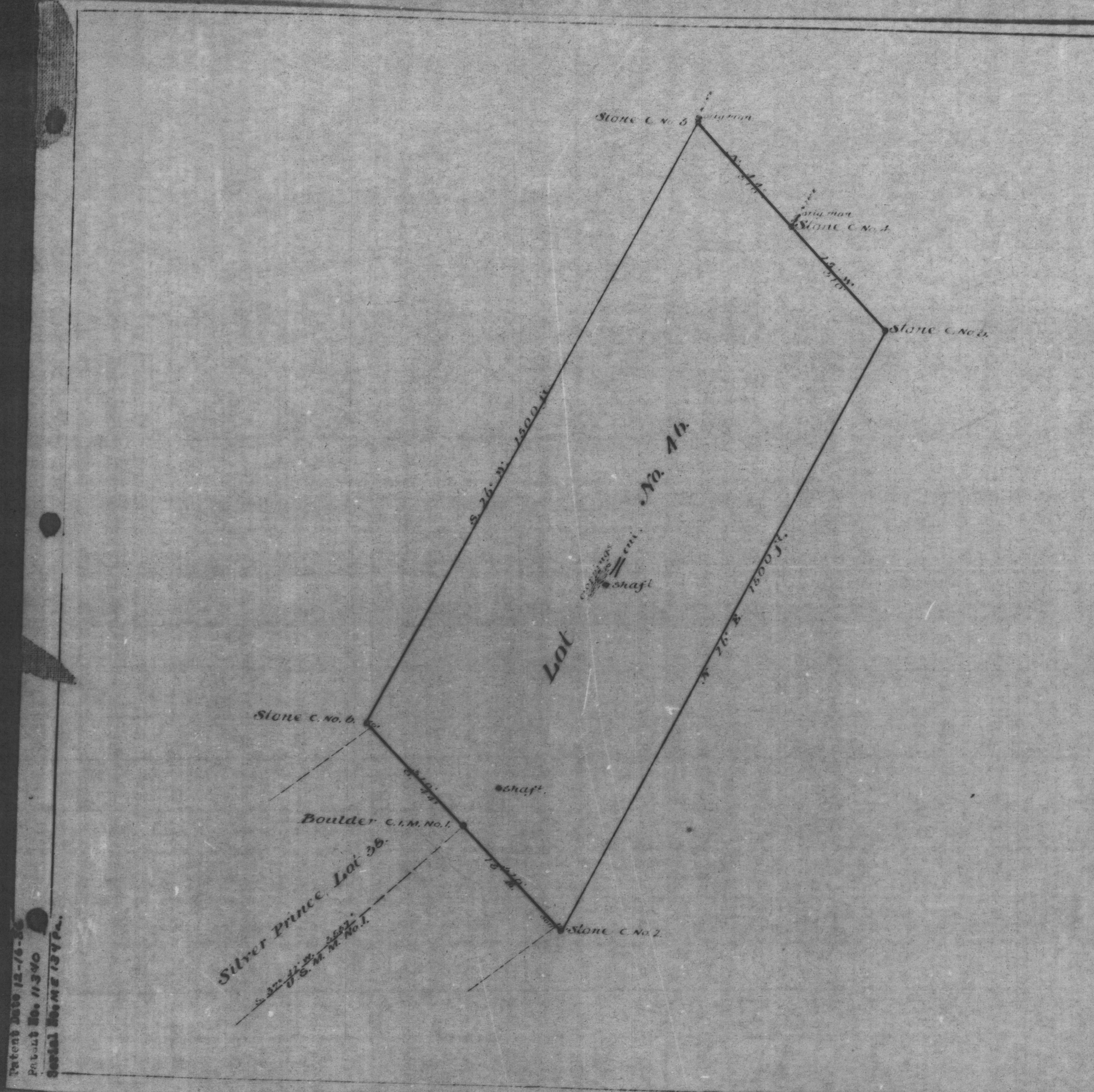
