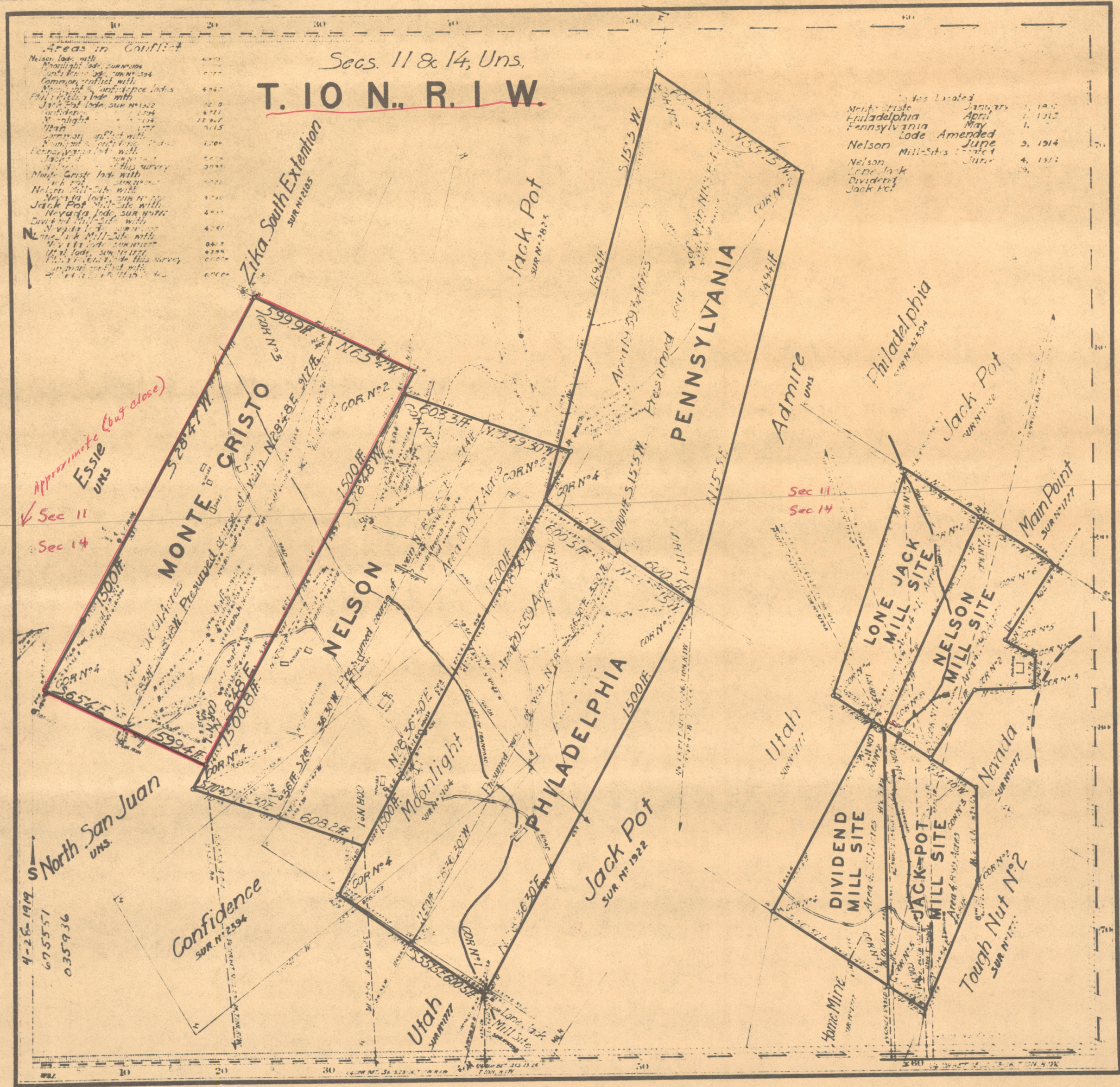

I further certify that five hundred dollars worth of labor has been expended or improvements made upon said Mining Claims by claimant or its assigns and that said improvements consist of 2 trenches, 2 cuts, 6 tunnels, 7 shafts and 12 adits, and an included interest value of \$1000 in Sec. 14 of Township 10 North, Range 1 West, in the Nelson, Pennsylvania and Philadelphia lodes of this survey and the Jack Pot lode, surface, and an undivided interest value of \$1000 in Sec. 11 of said Township, Range 1 West, in the Nelson, Pennsylvania, Philadelphia lodes of this survey and the Jack Pot, Dividend and Lone Jack lodes of this survey.
