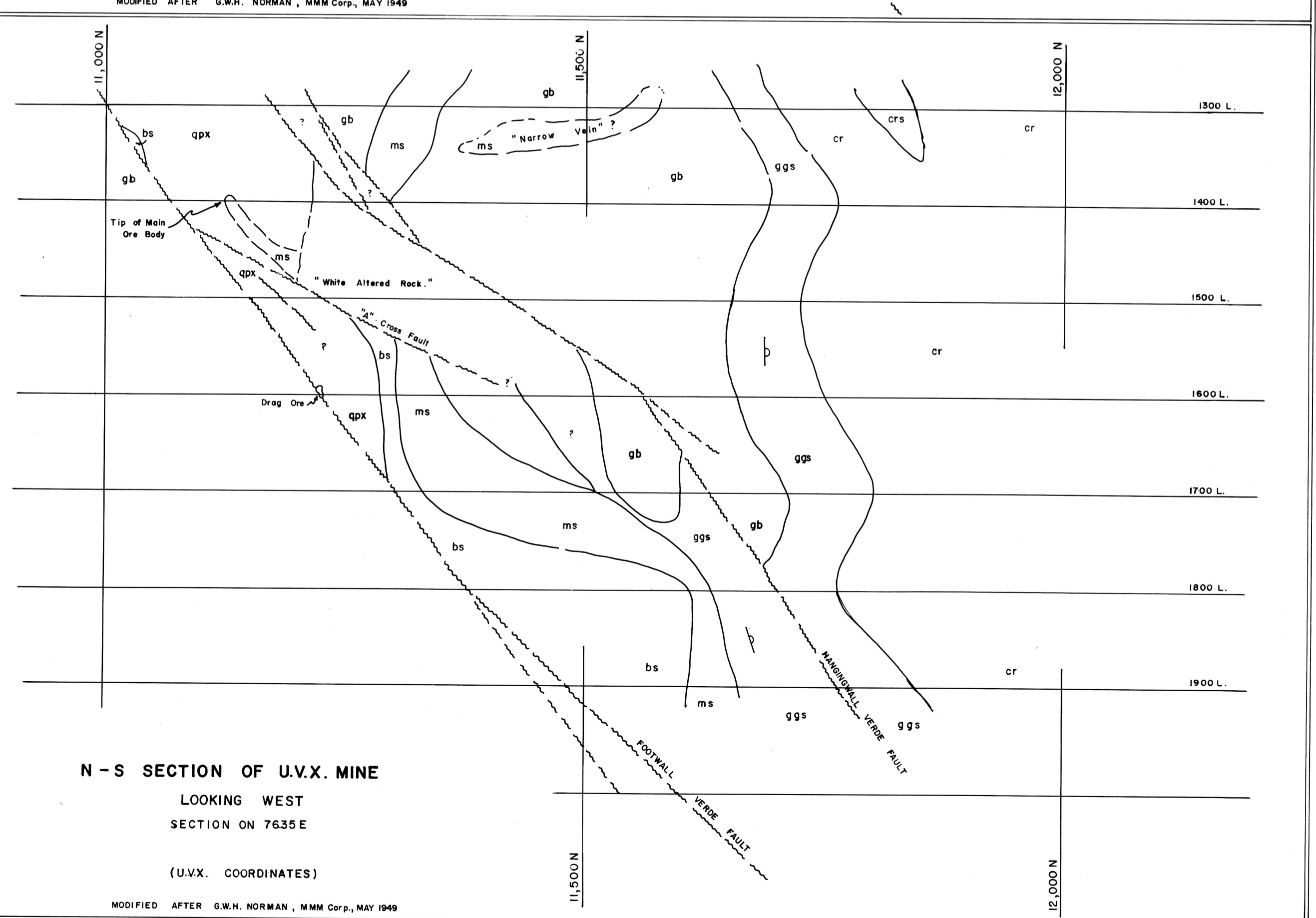
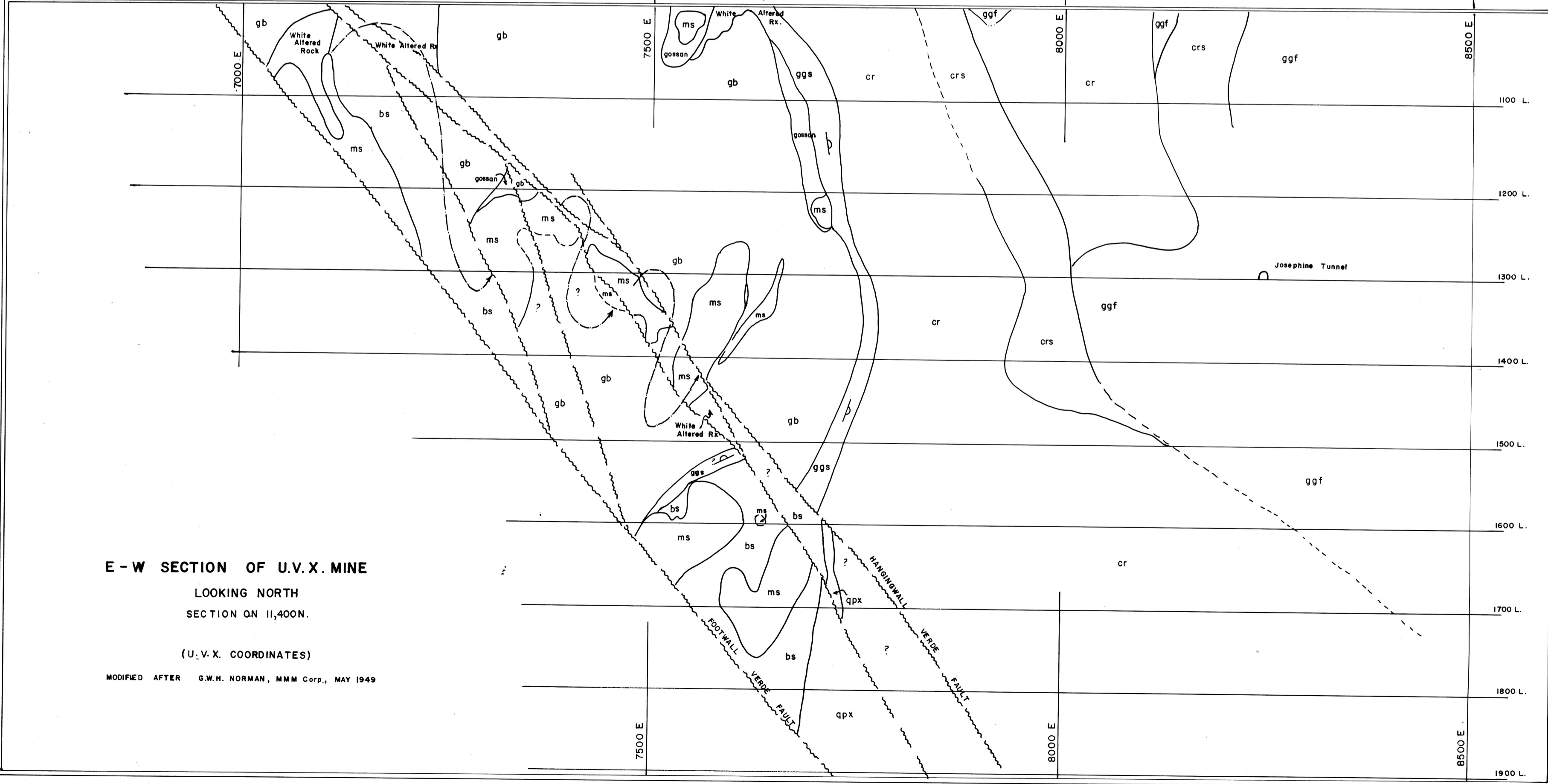
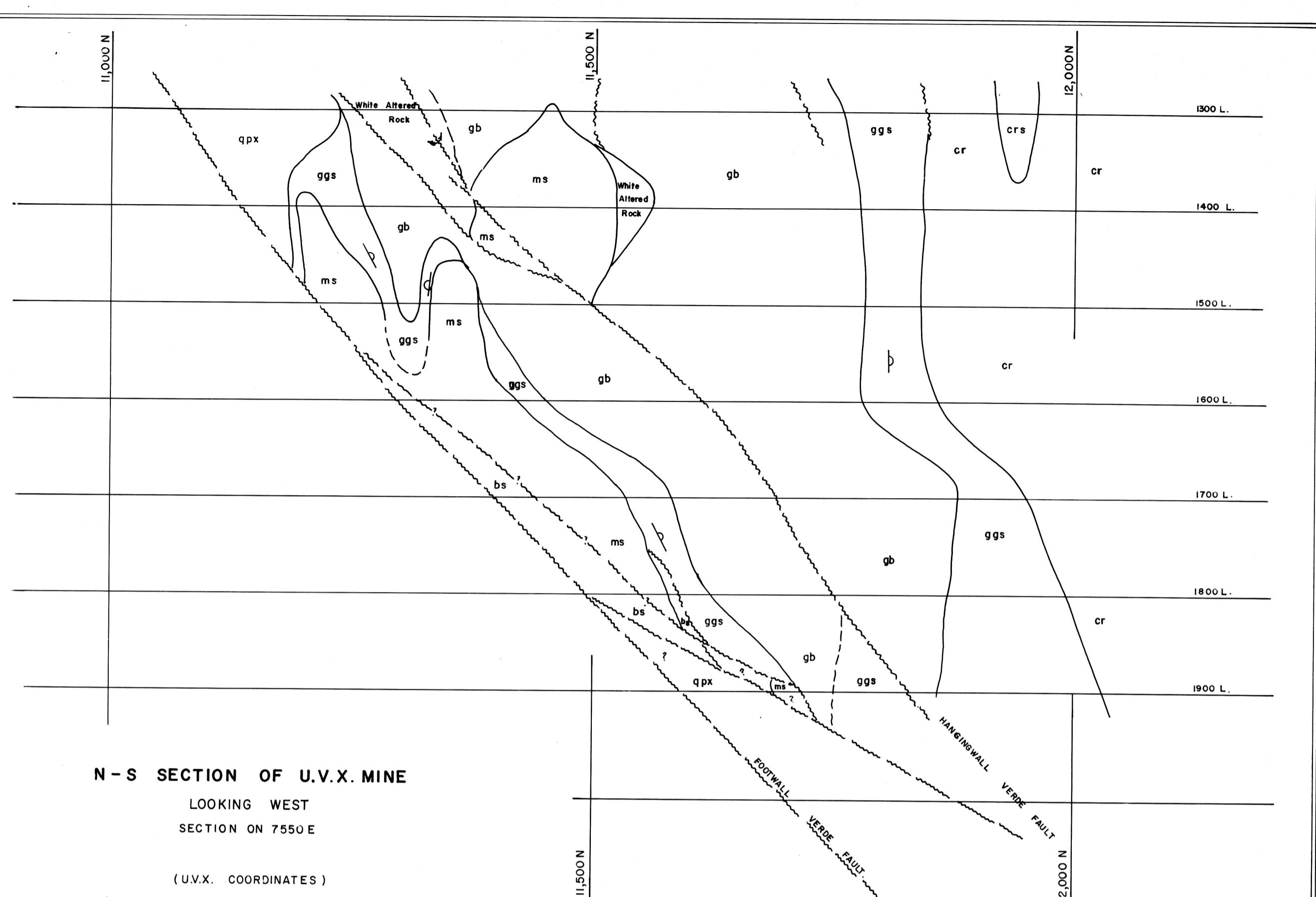
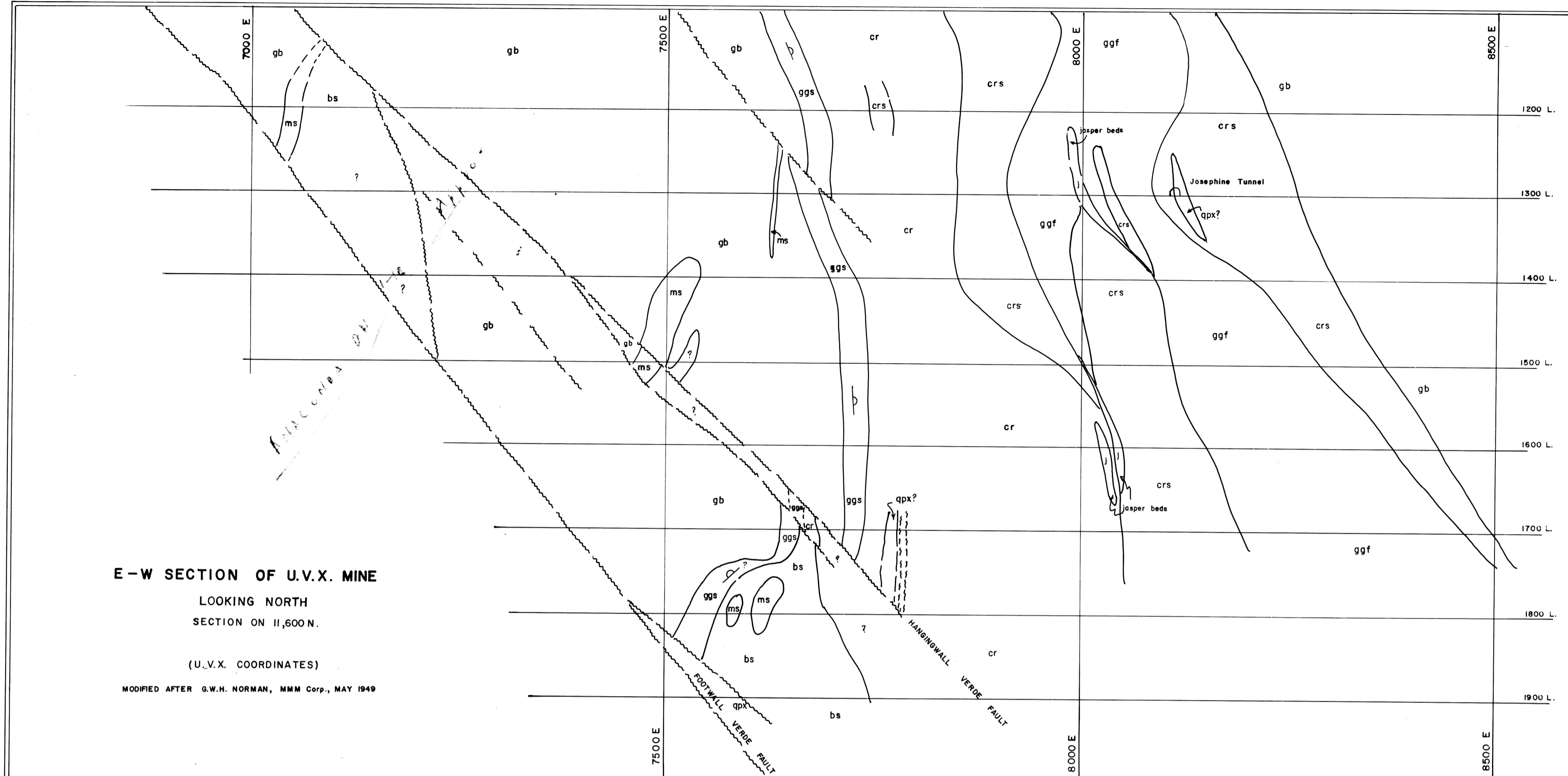


-NOTES-

1. Relative positions of massive sulphides and chloritic 'black schist' zones, one in regard to the other.
 2. Relative stratigraphic position of "apx" crystal tuff with regard to both sulphides and black schist.
 3. Stratigraphic sequence of the volcanic rocks, especially the "Cleopatra" rhyolites overlying the sulphide-crystal tuff "apx" combination, as based on top determinations in "ggs" interbeds facing easterly.
 4. Severe faulting that has sliced the sulphide mass repeatedly.
