



**EXPLANATION**

- Basalt  
 Lava flows, with some tuff. ("malapai"). Probably late Tertiary.
- Conglomerate  
 Partly consolidated stream gravel of pre-basalt age.
- Supai formation  
 Thin-bedded, red sandstone and shale, Permian and Pennsylvanian.
- Limestone  
 Carboniferous and Devonian.
- Basal sandstone  
 Probably Cambrian. Tapeats ss.
- Pre-Cambrian
  - Verde diorite
  - Cleopatra rhyolite
  - Deception rhyolite
  - Gold Hill rhyolite
  - Walnut Spring greenstone
  - Undifferentiated "greenstone"
  - United Verde quartz-sulfide body.
