above the 950 level.

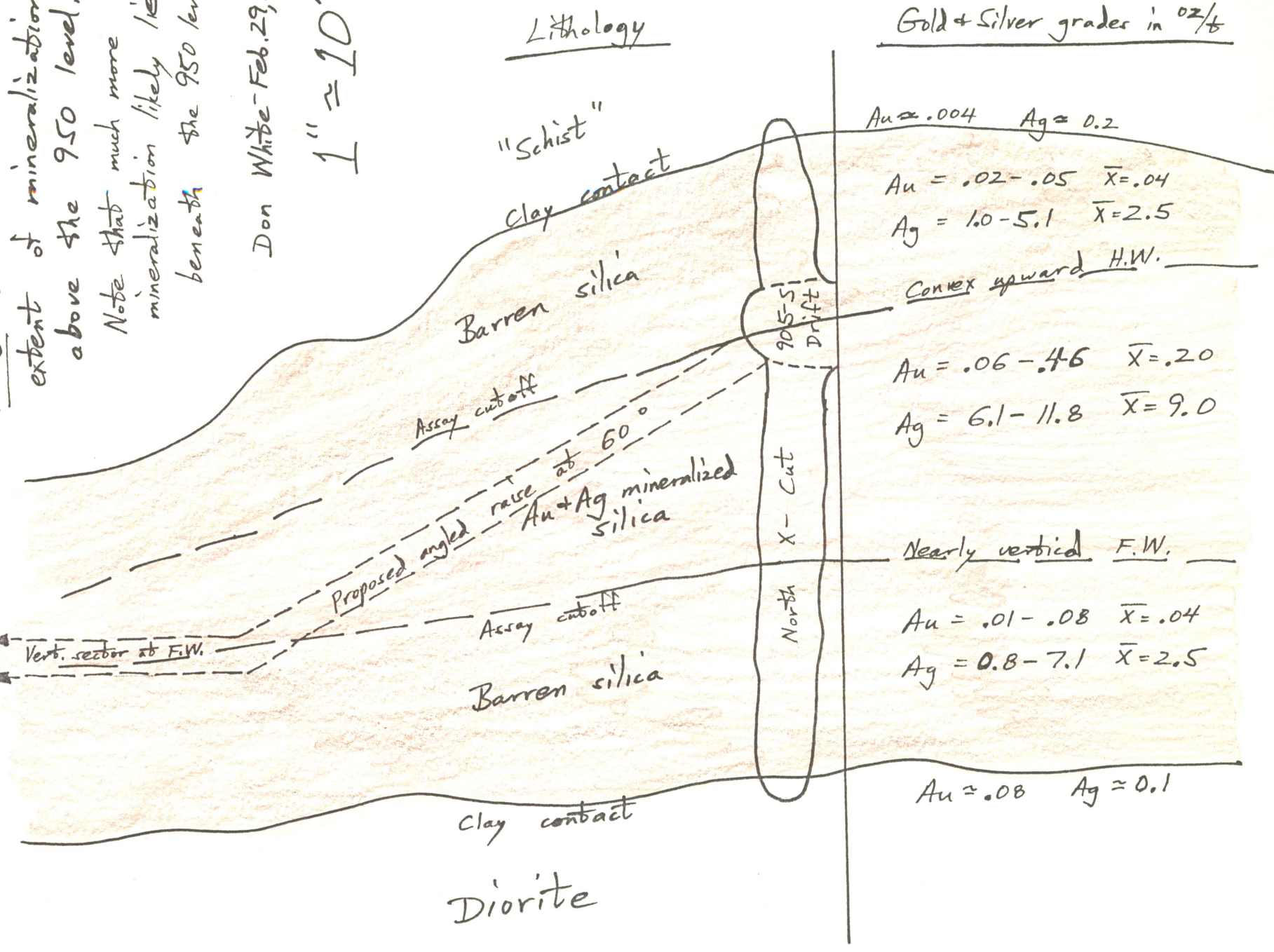
Note that much more

Gold + Silver grades in oz/t

Au ≈ 0.004 Ag ≈ 0.2

Au = .02 - .05 \bar{X} = .04
 Ag = 1.0 - 5.1 \bar{X} = 2.5

Convex upward H.W.

Au = .06 - .46 \bar{X} = .20
 Ag = 6.1 - 11.8 \bar{X} = 9.0

Nearly vertical F.W.

Au = .01 - .03 \bar{X} = .04
 Ag = 0.8 - 7.1 \bar{X} = 2.5

Au ≈ 0.08 Ag ≈ 0.1
